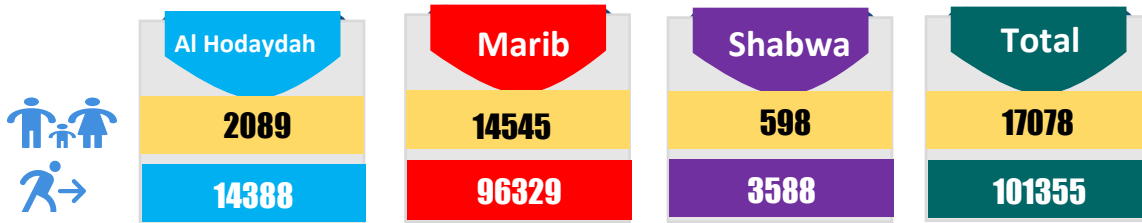

Introduction

The recent developments in Al Hodaydah Governorate (Ad Durayhimi, At Tuhayat, Alhawk and Alhali), Marib Governorate (Al Abdiyah, Rahaba, Al Jubah, Jabal Murad, Harib and Sirwah) and Shabwah Governorate (Bayhan and Usaylan) led to a wave of mass displacement of thousands of households. The Executive Unit for IDPs Camps Management immediately formed a committee of many teams to work 24 hours to (receive displaced households, monitoring households, distribute households on sites, find lands, register needs and send urgent appeals). The Executive Unit for IDPs Camps Management provided lands to receive displaced households and coordinated with the local authorities, local organizations and international organizations to speed up the access of humanitarian assistance.





Map (1): The places of displacement

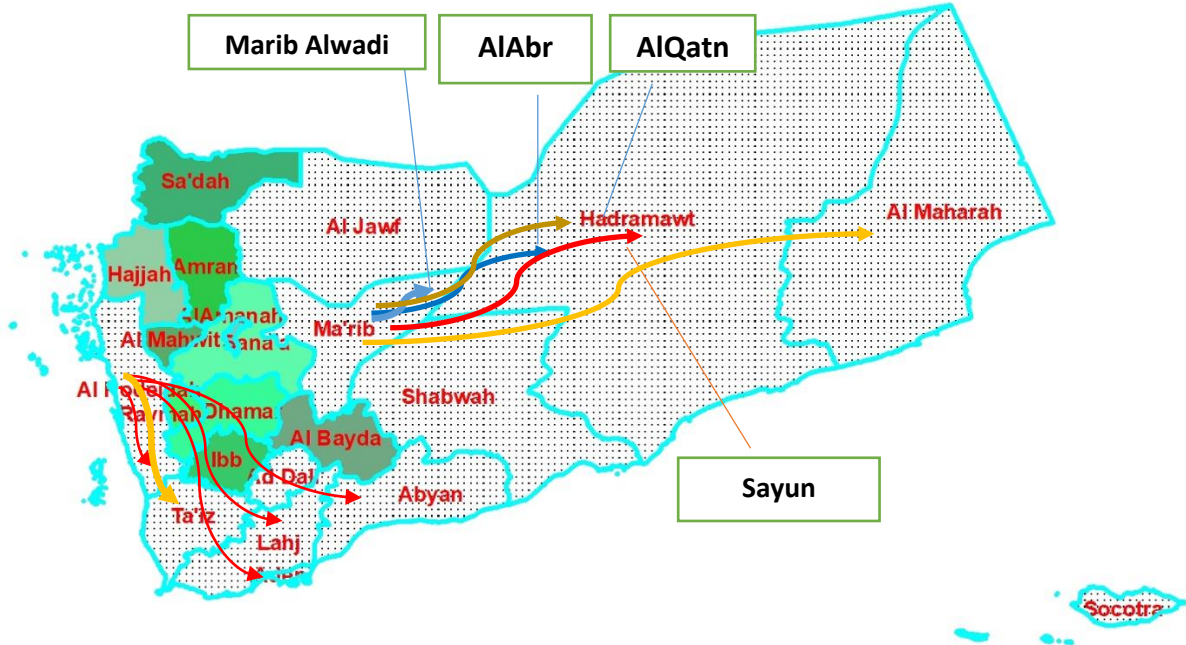

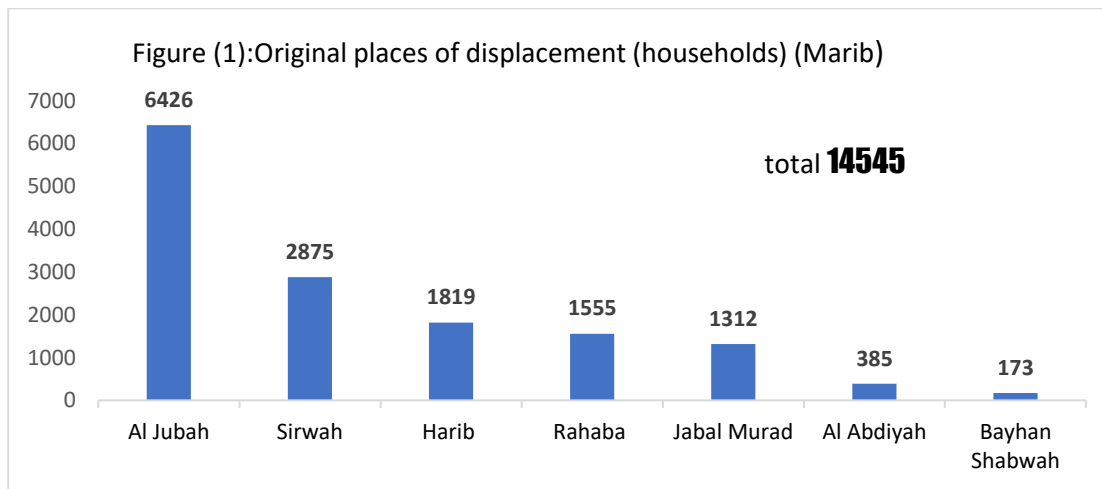

Figure (2): Original places of displacement (Households) (Al Hodaydah)

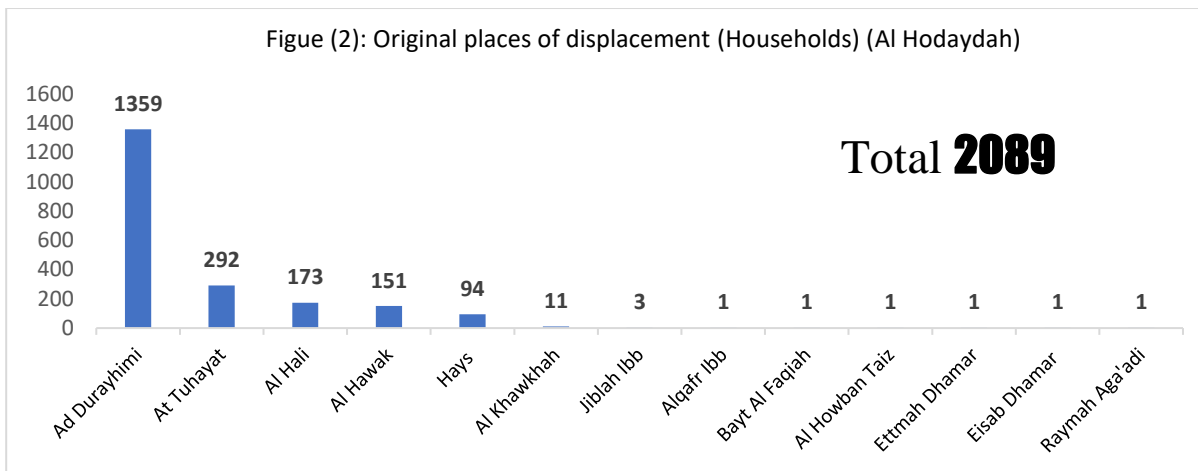

Recommendations

- ✓ Executive Unit for IDPs Camp Management appeals to humanitarian partners to respond quickly and provide emergency needs (food, shelter, water, medicines and protection).
- ✓ An emergency plan to receive and settle all IDPs should be put involving all humanitarian actors.
- ✓ All efforts and work should be performed by involving the security authorities and the host community so as to facilitate safe movement of IDPs to safe places.
- ✓ Numbers of IDPs should be taken from the Executive Unit for IDPs Camp Management as it is the official body concerned with IDPs camps management.
- ✓ Providing a stockpile (financial or in-kind) for emergency displacement in particular Marib Governorate in which displacement wave exceeded the ability of humanitarian actors.



Conclusion

The latest developments in Al Hodaydah, Marib and Shabwah governorates led to a wave of massive displacement from these governorates to other governorates under the control of the internationally recognized government. (17078) households with (101355) individuals were registered. Most of the displaced households in Marib were registered in Marib Alwadi and Marib City. In Al Hodaydah Governorate, the most displaced households were registered in Al Khawkhah and Al Mukha. In Shabwah, the most displaced households were registered in Attaq.
