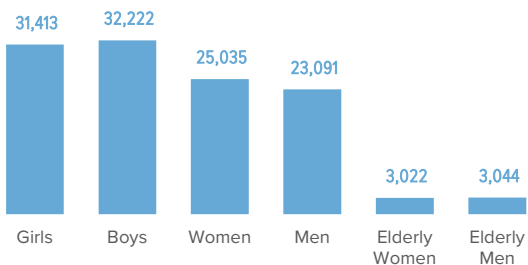

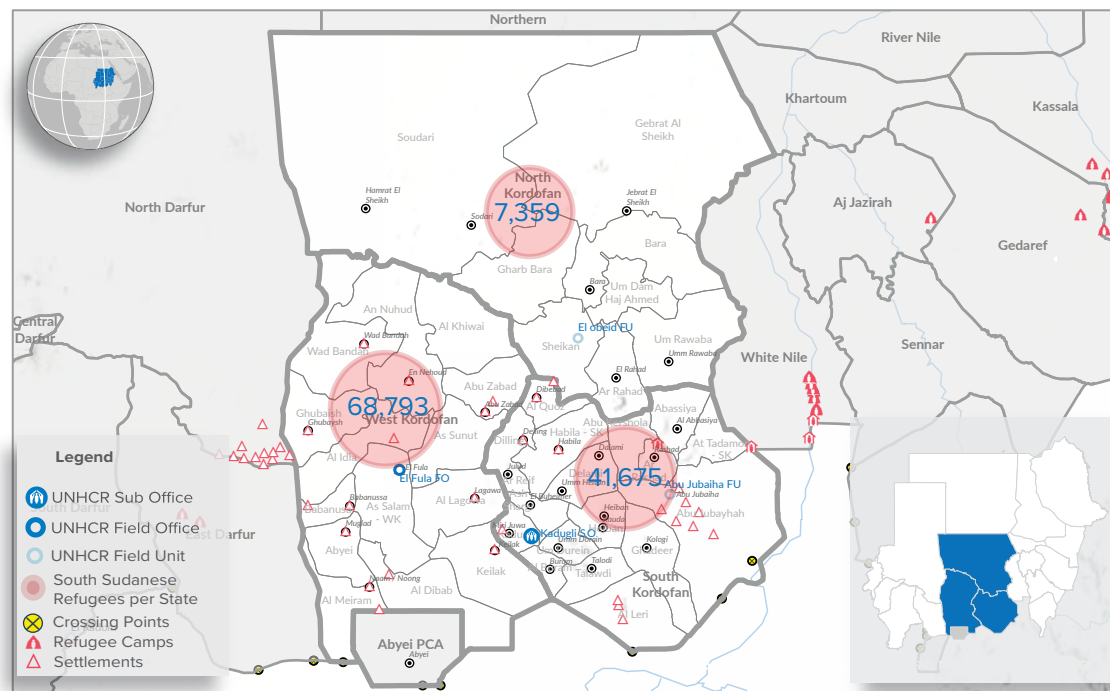
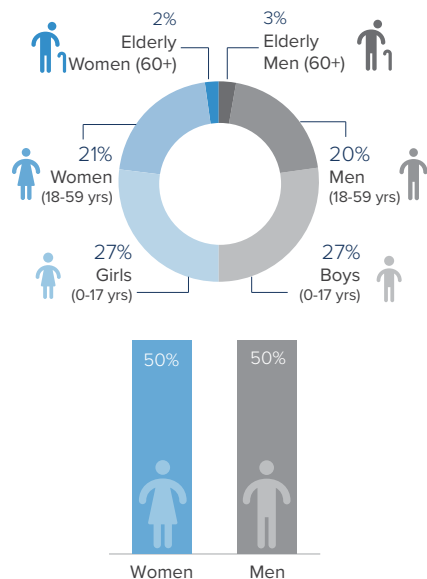

Registered Refugees Per Demographics

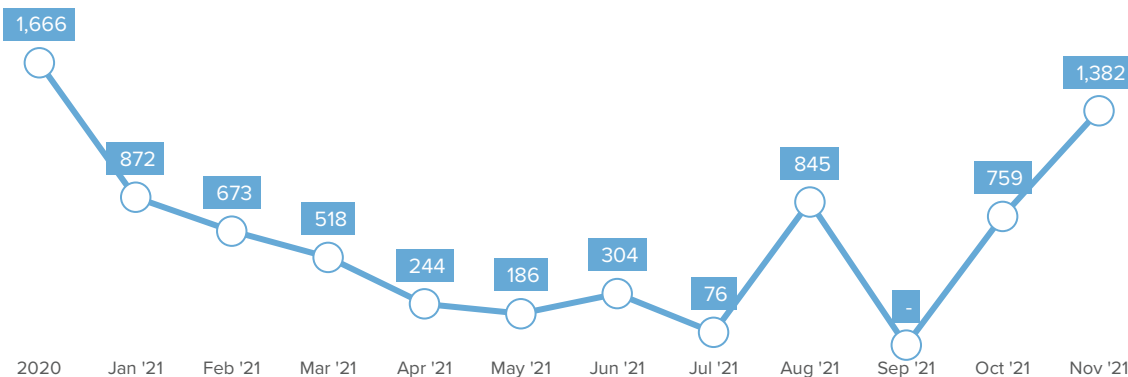

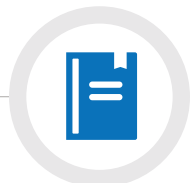
3-days infection prevention and control measures training to 38 refugee leaders and health cadres from refugee and host community in Abu Jubayhah
