


Map of verified IDP sites in Jalalagsi - January 2022

Assessment overview

A joint IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Jalalagsi in January 2022. The operation was led by CCCM partners, MRDO and SOMLIFE. 6 IDP sites were identified hosting 2,352 households or 14,599 individuals. This is the first time site verification has been done in Jalalaqsi.

People living with health difficulty

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with health difficulty were

877 (60% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

437 (51% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

243 (55% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

360 (64% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

134 (74% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

132 (62% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

2,183 (15%)

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

100% of IDP sites have been classified

100% of sites are landowner authorized occupancy

100% of sites have agreements in place

100% of those that have agreements have oral agreements


100% of those that have agreements have agreed end dates

100% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

1 IDP sites (17%) have been classified
