<p><b>Context updates</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>ACTED</b> briefed on continued transportation provided to refugees: bus transfers to Iasi, Romania, ranging from 4 persons on Monday, 9-Sunday), bus to Chisinau (2-Monday, 29 persons- Sunday), shuttle from BCPs to connect with other bus routes, extra van for RACs. <a href="#">To check whether transport can be provided from Blue Dot to Calaraseuca RAC for overnight stays?</a>. Cash program for refugees jointly with Mayor’s Office (and <a href="#">whether hosts to be included tbc</a>).</li> <li>2. <b>Mayor’s Office, Border Police, LCA/CDA</b> – confirmed the tendency for the past weeks that Ukrainians continue to enter Otaci BCP for cash, food, petrol, and majority returns to UKR afterwards.</li> <li>3. <b>BMA</b> informed on the total number of 2589 refugee applications from Feb.</li> <li>4. Nikolay from <b>IOM</b> updated regarding the temporary bus station site’s gravelling, cleaning of construction garbage, ongoing as per contractor’s plan. <a href="#">Request to share the schedule.</a></li> <li>5. Andrea from <b>UNHCR</b> showed to all participants the site plan in details that jointly with IOM Keisuke she was working on and <a href="#">it will be shared with all participants</a>, although it is not the final version yet. (Andrea will return to Otaci meeting on 14 June).</li> </ol> <p>Next meeting on 7 June at 2 pm, as usual.</p> <p>After the meeting, the plan’s copy was shown and given to the Mayor, who also asked about the <u>electricity options</u> for the site; <a href="#">Andrea with Keisuke will discuss this further.</a></p>
