Agreed with WFP, Acted will take over 5 accredited RACs from WCK, on July 16, 2022. Vouchers have been provided to 1 RAC.</li> <li>• CRS/Caritas Moldova - provides hot meals to 10 RACs, 3 meals/day/person. Food assistance outside RACs – vouchers (3000 lei) for Linella. Chisinau – 30% showed up for cash assistance. 2500 refugee registered families received cash from UNHCR and not yet from CRS.</li> <li>• HelpAge - provides support to 29 RACs (22 catering, 7 vouchers/on site cooking).</li> </ul>	<b>Action: N/A</b>
<b>Brief review of FSWG TOR</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In response to refugees’ influx in Moldova, a Food Security Sub-Working Group was established to address food security needs of those refugees, involving relevant technical members from UN, government line ministries (ANAS/ANSA) and NGOs.</li> </ul>	<b>Action: N/A</b>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The FSSWG is chaired and coordinated by UN World Food Programme.</li> <li>• Main objectives:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Support in the response to refugees’ influx and ensure coordination among the members</li> <li>2. Provide regular data, analysis, and information.</li> <li>3. Help develop policy package.</li> <li>4. Support the delivery of food assistance response that is informed by need assessments and monitoring, addresses gaps and mitigates duplication.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• See the document “ToR for FSSWG Template”.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>AOB: Request from the Ministry of Interior on contingency support</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To provide food assistance (daily) for the employees involved in 5 provisional centers, close to border crossing points.</li> <li>• Total number of people for each provisional center:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Palanca Provisional Center - 16</li> <li>2. Giugulesti Provisional Center - 12</li> <li>3. Pirlita Provisional Center – 6</li> </ol> </li> <li>• Main important part of the request is to support the Ministry with contingency, which may include vouchers or food commodity – 7000 refugees for 3 days. They have facilities to store the food (refrigerators etc).</li> <li>• 2 RACs are frozen and can be opened, when it will be necessary.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Action:</b> NGOs interested on provision of the requested support need to contact WFP</p>
