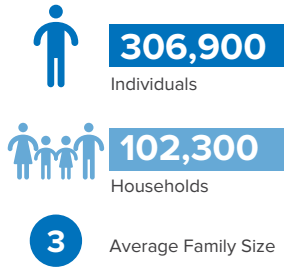


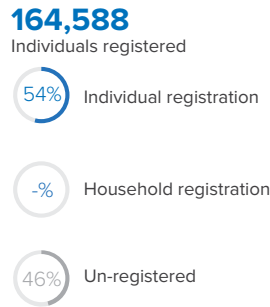

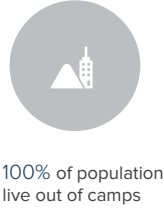

Population Distribution



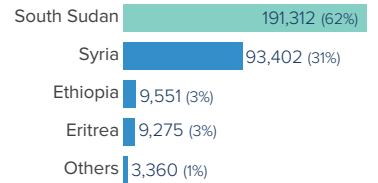

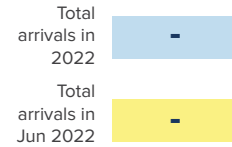

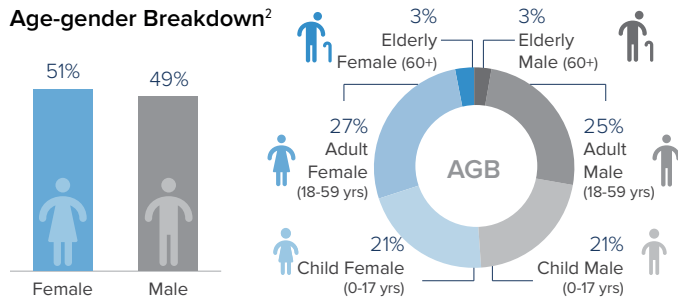

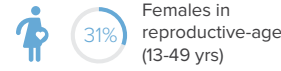

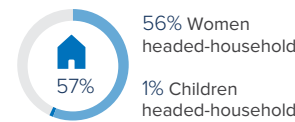
Age-gender Breakdown²



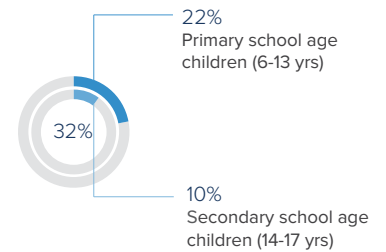
Reproductive-age Women/Girls²



Household Distribution²

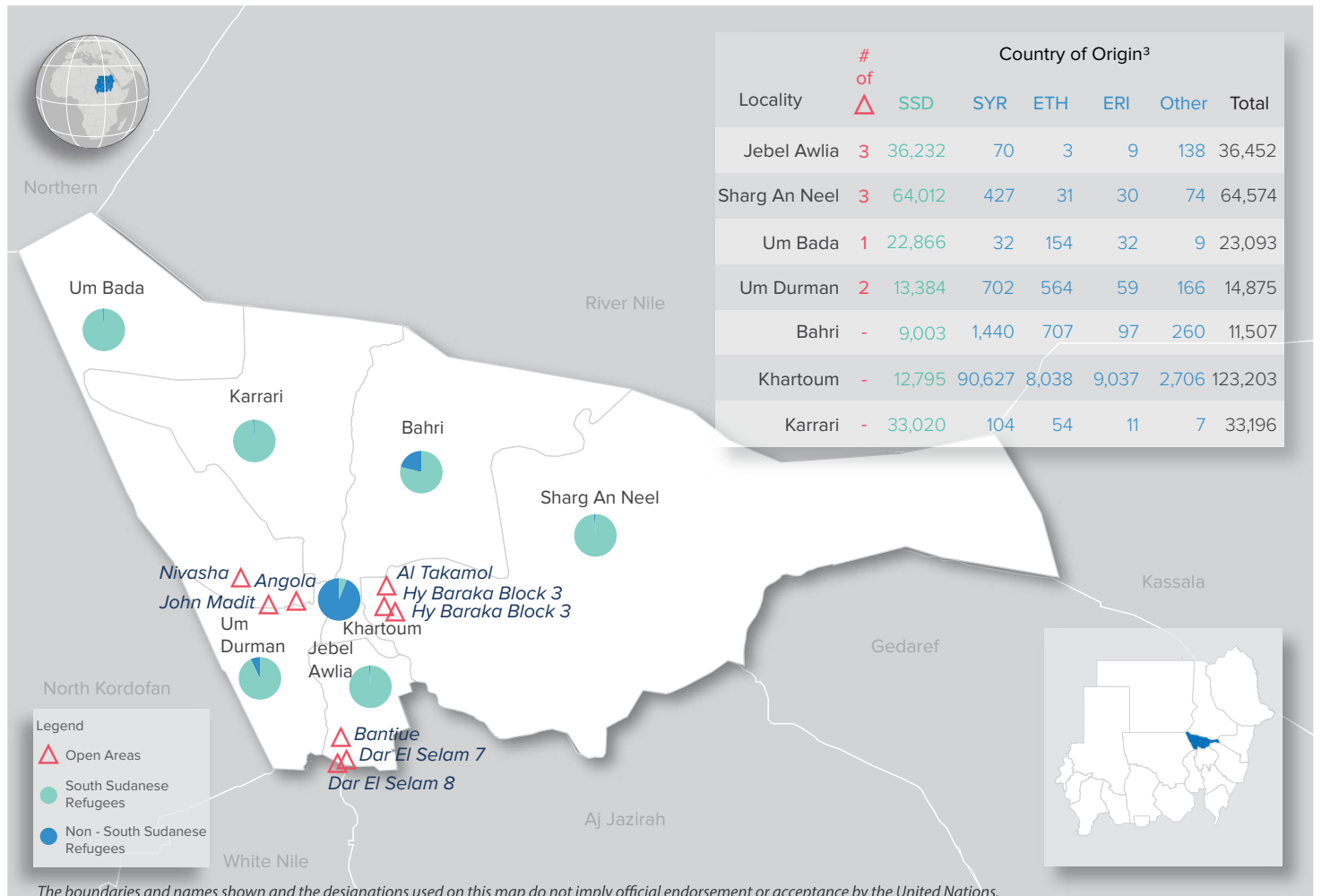


School-age Children²
