Decisions and action points

1. Take stock of the existing resources developed in another similar crises (including during the COVID crisis);
2. Coordinate actions and resources between different organizations (sometimes this might mean approaching/having the same donor, and all actors should be a cooperative)
3. Mapping who is doing what (to include both actions already taken and plans) – please fill in this format by **COB Wed, 13 April**:

4. Consider involving the local authorities;
5. Share the response plan developed by the Government with the members of the SWG (to be confirmed by MoE) and discuss Costing of the sectoral plan;
6. Keep the flexibility as a principle in developing and adjusting the response plans (both RRP and national action plan);
7. Consider the inclusion of the third country nationals in the measures and actions within the RRP;
8. Identify what is the type of the technical support that the national and county authorities will need to implement the RRP;

9. Consider cross-border cooperation (especially for humanitarian actors who operate in different neighboring countries);
10. Exchange of experience in education between Ministries from Romania, Moldova, Ukraine etc.;
11. Support for strengthening the data collection mechanism and Include the voice of children into the data collection;
12. Share updates about the needs assessments;
