

Education Working Group minutes : 29/06/22

- Round of introduction (HCR/ UNICEF / TDH / NRC / SCF)

- 1- Points to follow from previous meeting : youth / Romanian language summer programme / June updates
 - Share the methodology used by WVI. But currently focal point unavailable (keep it as an action point ?)
 - Similarly MoE focal point may have dropped out (because of health issues and fact that exams are taking place at the same time), but they are working on putting place the normative framework for access of ukraininan children to Romanian cycle (although no normative barrier exists since 2013).
 - Romanian language training usually in summer with civil society and voluntary teachers but no firm plan yet
 - Practical information available on the website in various languages
 - Question from NRC : may be prepare a one pager in case people have no access to website or do not know it (including school principals)
 - Mirna WVI this info sharing is part of our mandate so we could indeed go for this, especially after the Bacalaureate, to organize a meeting with MoE to agree on both side on practical steps – using opportunity of the Summer
 - So EWG could prepare something but that would require approbation of the ministry and we must be both concise and very clear to avoid that each school interpret in its own way.

- 2- Youth task team meeting
 - No formal system set up yet (although UNICEF & HCR explored potential ToRs for at least the blue dot)
 - Could may be be reinforced after need assessment so we better understand needs
 - Need to also map existing NGOs
 - In the meantime Ahmed can share unformal updates, so in the meantime mportant to indeed keep this under the agenda in the absence of alternative fora

- 3- Needs assessment (Tetyana)
 - We do have an agreement with the research company
 - It is a specific unicef one (although ToRs were shared)
 - 5W are being reviewed with UNHCR

- 4- TOUR DE TABLE
 - Abdulahi : trained 207 teachers on social learning (Bucaresti and constanta), and started the summer camps on 1st of June, that will continue till 15th of July on BHS. Summer camps support 220 children so far
 - On WVI : summer languages classes in Bucaresti and Cluz – also exploring with Brazov. Three more centers will be created, including on Non Formal education for children, psychosocial support..., they will also extent to Iasi. Also a container in Romexpo (more family-aimed to date). The big issue is the coming school year.
 - Jessica SCF: modules existing in (shared in the chat') mobile school operating in Bucharest for outreach of Ukrainian children. New summer schools being set up next. Still collecting the pieces of the puzzle

- From UNICEF : partnership with Romanian Regina Maria. We provided education kits for some directorates in CP. Exploring possibility to reinforce partnership with other partners. Developing partnership with MoE for platform to gather data. Will be tested in Bucharest first. We also may want to expand our cooperation with tertiary education. Parenting education also continues (Carmen : an appeal was launched for play and learning ECD preschool with municipalities having capacity to apply. Currently downloading the application)
