<b>Introduction of new partners</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Good Neighbours joined the meeting for the first time. The Organization works in 7 international locations and focuses, in Romania, on the delivery of food and medicine through local NGOs.</li></ul>	
<b>Updates on the 5Ws and the KoboTool</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Few organizations filled out the 5Ws document.</li><li>• The KoboTool was filled out only by Habitat for Humanity.</li><li>• Habitat for Humanity pointed out the issues with the GPS coordinates - they can only be filled out manually. Moreover, the partners proposed to update the tool to receive a confirmation email once it is filled out.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sector Leads to schedule bilateral meeting with each partner, to go together through the 5Ws and fill it out.</li><li>• Sector Leads to re-share the link to the KoboTool.</li><li>• Sector Leads will share these issues with the IMO.</li></ul>
<b>Presentation of partners' activities and experiences</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• DRC initially scheduled to provide NFIs, but then switched to voucher distribution - 200 lei/person for extremely vulnerable people (elderly, children, families with 4 or more dependents, etc).</li><li>• Habitat for Humanity continues to rent out apartments for refugees. The organization manages 27 apartments in which</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• UNICEF offered to support the National Youth Foundation - representatives will get in touch.</li></ul>

	<p>around 85 people are staying. Each apartment received a basic goods kit for their kitchen and bedroom.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• World Vision continues to support Romexpo and partners with hygiene and food items. As the organization still has a lot of funds, the team is looking to take the funds and support families with 200 lei/child, integral payment for 3 months.</li> <li>• Unicef is looking to systemize the service centers (10-11 Blue Dots). They do not have a WASH expert yet, there is a need to strengthen this part.</li> <li>• The National Youth Foundation opened new youth centers in Bucharest - 5 in total, in which they employ Ukrainians.</li> </ul>
