<p>Rumor tracking presentation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Moldova for peace information unit started the rumor tracking exercise. Findings of the first pilot round were presented. • The information presented in the report is based on the results of monitoring the most popular social networks, in particular those dedicated to refugees. One of the problems that refugees face is the lack of access to reliable and complete information. This situation gives rise to numerous rumors. • The most active rumors go around such topics: border crossing regulations, access to education, cash assistance and access to medical support. Moldova for Peace observed decrease in rumors spreading around the cash assistance following the meeting with the CWG partners. • The most relevant information requests coming from refugees are the rules for enrolling children in school. The main question is under what conditions a child can be enrolled in school, so as not to be an auditor, but a fully enrolled student. This issue is brought to the attention of the Government and Crisis Cell by UNICEF and UNHCR. • UNICEF informed that their team is currently working on information materials that will outline the mechanism for enrolling children from refugee families in schools. 	<p>Activity: Moldova for Peace will provide regular updates on the rumour tracking findings.
