<p><b>Agenda Point 1</b></p> <p>Operational updates by members</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>ACTED</u> – the number of hot meals distributed in august is 16 572. Starting October 1, Acted will take over RAC ID 35 from AAR Japan. The RAC manager will receive help in the form of vouchers, to cook on site 3 meals a day for the beneficiaries. Also, RAC ID 59 asked for the third meal, as the other partner who has proving dinner will stop its activity there. The RAC in Copceac, called the voucher pilot project, is going smoothly with good feedback from the beneficiaries.</li> <li>• <u>HelpAge</u> – continues to support refugees, providing 3 hot meals daily in 25 accredited RACs (22 RACs - catering and 3 RACs - vouchers). A meeting with AAR Japan and representatives of the RAC ID 117 will be organized next week, to discuss the possibility of taking over this center from October 1.</li> <li>• <u>World Vision</u> – continues to provide food assistance. A new programme with the new donors DECK has started in September and will last for one year.</li> <li>• <u>Solidarites</u> - continues to provide food assistance (3 meals/day/person) in 6 RACs (1 of them is an accredited one). The number of beneficiaries is around 100 per day.</li> </ul>	<p>To come up with new updates at the next meeting.</p> <p>World Vision will share the last updates for the past weeks with WFP by email.</p>
<p><b>Agenda Point 2</b></p> <p>Monthly IA Updates</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The information published for July is not reflecting what has been shared with IA Coordination Team. WFP will try to understand what happened and if there is a way to change the narratives.</li> <li>• Now the reporting period for August (from 1<sup>st</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup>) has started. The deadline for sector leads to provide the narrative on behalf of the working group is 15th of September.</li> <li>• The new report with August updates will be published at the end of September.</li> </ul>	<p>Each member of FSWG is kindly asked to share his inputs (1 paragraph) about food assistance activities in the next 9 days.</p>
<p><b>Agenda Point 3</b></p> <p>AOB</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In the last Inter Agency meeting it was requested to discuss with all the members of the working group about the possibility to switch from to 1 meeting every 2 weeks.</li> <li>• If there are more changes in a short period of time, especially in winter, an ad-hock meeting can be easily organized.</li> </ul>	<p>A follow up email with the new invites will be send next week by WFP. <b>Next meeting on 20.09.2022</b></p>
