<p><b>RRP Recalibration 2022</b></p> <p>Diego Nardi, Inter-Agency Coordinator Officer, ISCG Lead <a href="mailto:nardid@unhcr.org">nardid@unhcr.org</a></p> <p>Yurii Arnautov, Information Management Working Group Lead, UNHCR <a href="mailto:arnautov@unhcr.org">arnautov@unhcr.org</a></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An RRP mid-year revision will be done regionally with the countries working in the response of the Ukrainian situation, including Moldova.</li> <li>• Moldova already reached half of the figures of the April Moldova Planning Figures. The other half considers the potential influx of refugees from the Odessa/ contingency plan scenario.</li> <li>• The ISCG agreed that UN Agencies and other INGOs with more financial responsibilities should review the activities and targets. The IAC team will share bilaterally with each sector-lead/main UN organization a list of the top five main partners that received funding.</li> <li>• The targets and activities can be open for discussion and reviewed. If necessary, main organizations will be able to review activities and re-prioritize for the remainder of the year. The budget can be reallocated from different activities according to new needs. (i.e., to prioritize a winterization activity). The IAC team will share bilaterally with each sector-lead targets for revision.</li> <li>• The envelope of the Moldovan Refugee Response 2022 cannot be open and complemented, and new fund requests are not going to be made to donors. New organizations will have the opportunity to apply for funds in the RRP 2023 that will be further discussed in the ISCG.</li> <li>• The RRP 2022 Indicators will not be open for discussion and changed.</li> <li>• The Winterization Strategy is within scope of the 2022 Recalibration exercise. The RRP recalibration is connected to the Winterization Planning Process. The objective is to map existing capacities and gaps per sector and avoid duplication of activities and waste of resources.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>The 1st step</b> was the <b>mapping of winter planned activities</b> via the Winterization Kobo Form by all RCF members. The deadline was extended to 12 August. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Organizations who have pledged in April to the RRP should specify in the Kobo Form if the winter activity was previously included. This was done in order to maintain track of information and verify the availability of funds and the need of reprioritization in the 2022 RRP Recalibration exercise.</li> </ul> </li> <li>● <b>The 2nd step</b> is the <b>data revision by the Inter-Agency Coordination team</b>. The information collected will be shared with Sector-Leads and the RCF members during the RCF meeting on 15 August.</li> <li>● <b>The 3rd step</b> is the <b>data analysis of each Sector-Lead within their respective sector group</b> to re-prioritize and plan winter activities to avoid duplication and waste of resources. The sectoral winter plan activities and information must be included in the IAC template shared. <u>The deadline to send the filled template is 2nd September.</u></li> <li>● <b>The Winterization Strategy Workshop</b> estimated date is in the first week of September. The objective is to have an <b>Inter-Agency Winterization Strategy jointly drafted by different sectors</b> to strengthen humanitarian efforts during the winter period which starts in October.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Activity:</b> Revision of the winter planned activities by RFC according to Sector <b>Responsible:</b> IAC team <b>Deadline:</b> 15 August</p>
