
Map of verified IDP sites in Baardheere - October 2022

Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Baardheere in October 2022 led by the Wadani Relief Organisation (WARO), Horn of Africa Relief and Development Agency (HARDA), GREDO, HDC, NoFYL, IOM, IRW, Islamic Relief, SADO and SEDHURO. 35 IDP sites were identified hosting 11,994 households or 71,964 individuals. Compared to the last site verification conducted in June 2022, there was an increase of 12 IDP sites and a decrease of 1,976 Households but an increase of 101 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the Washington Group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were derived

- 122 (43% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)
- 117 (42% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)
- 89 (46% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding
- 132 (49% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs
- 73 (53% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing
- 77 (42% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

610 (0.9%) people living with disability

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.


- 91% of sites have landowner authorized ownership type of land tenure
- 100% of sites have agreement in place
- 97% of those that have agreements have oral agreements
- 87% of those that have agreements have no agreed end dates
- 20% of sites have been issued with eviction notice within the last 3 months

7 IDP sites have been classified as having high risk of eviction

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.

23% of the sites has been classified as extreme (always floods) and high (floods frequently)



Newly Formed Sites

IDP sites were assessed based on their year of formation

5 IDP sites were formed in the last 6 months
