Presentation from IZA Association on anti-trafficking activities they do on field	<p>Courtney's presentation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● 60 beneficiaries served up to now</li> <li>● 58 refugees out of 60 want to go back to Ukraine - they want to wait until there is peace</li> <li>● They want to take their kids to school, but there is no really good option for them for education</li> <li>● 6 are currently working - child care a big concern - they do not know where to leave their children</li> <li>● No risk of trafficking until now.</li> <li>● Challenge: lack of effort/options for long term integration</li> <li>● IZA association are planning to do activities for refugees until the end of October</li> </ul>
