JRS- 63 audience in Brasov plus 38 registered in the preschooling system, in Constanta they have a special class for weekend (80 enrolled for these classes).

The audience will receive support from the government.

- ✚ Audience decreased- a problem that needs to be solved
- ✚ In Constanta local authorities established bus line from North Mamaia to the center in order for the children to access education (11000 children)
- ✚ In Brasov they want to open an education hub
- ✚ We should have a national meeting with all our partners to share good lessons learned

Save the Children- Suceava and Iasi encountered many difficulties for children- they try to find ukrainian communities.

Q: How the partners can find the ukrainian teachers/teachers with ukrainian background or we have a database?

UNICEF- Recently a massive donation from Lego that will be spread out for some of the ECD centers.

- ✚ We need to look what is happening in the cities without blue dots- in Sibiu, Cluj, Timisoara, Sighisoara and the entire Maramures to have equity

Q: What is the situation in small cities?

- ✚ 23 schools registered, in Ploiesti we have 3 classes provided by the Palace of Children in but the teachers are unpaid
- ✚ Mihai Viteazu has issues to recruit ukrainian teachers or people with educational background from Ukraine. They are on the top willing to get employed and they can work in dealing with these issues
- ✚ In Bacau we need schools and in Valcea but it's difficult to ask for funding
- ✚ Cluj and Targu Mures had a joint project but they have been rejected
- ✚ UNICEF, British Council and IOM training in December - Ukrainian and Romanian teachers working with Ukrainian refugee children in particular
