| <p>MHPSS Programming and Planning for UKR Response in Romania</p> | <p>Estuar Foundation: Providing social services including MHPSS for people coming from UKR and their families. Partnership with Municipalities (Bucharest, 2nd district), also planning a crisis intervention webinar.</p> <p>Plan International: Border points and Bucharest, focusing on children/adolescent and gender. In partnership with local actors (ADRA). Working in blue dots in 6 border crossing points. Capacity building initiative such as PFA</p> <p>ADRA: Planning on establishing Blue Dots with Plan international also with NRC</p> <p>Save the Children: Regional response covers UKR and POL. For Romania, planning multi year programming alongside with response in border crossing points.</p> <p>TdH: In border points, 9 Mobile teams include psychologists, nurses, social workers. Also, provide dignity kits wherever needed. Establishing CFS and mother/baby corners. Movement/Games/Sports approach will be used. Established a waiting room in the train stations.</p> <p>SOS: Capacity building for local organization and volunteers on PFA, self-care, MHPSS principles. Planning psychoeducation sessions (stress management), and individual counselling. Establishing child friendly corners.</p> <p>National Centre for MH: Propose health policies to MoH regarding MH. Focusing on service provision for people with addiction especially heroin. Also, can provide official data if needed regarding MH. In partnership with NGOs.</p> <p>IFCR: Planning MHPSS response with Romania Delegate. Important to link up with related partners. Focusing on increasing capacity of volunteers, providing ToTs, providing trainings in local language.</p> | |
