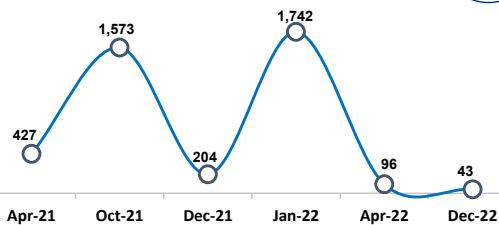

**Main departments of origin in Burkina Faso**

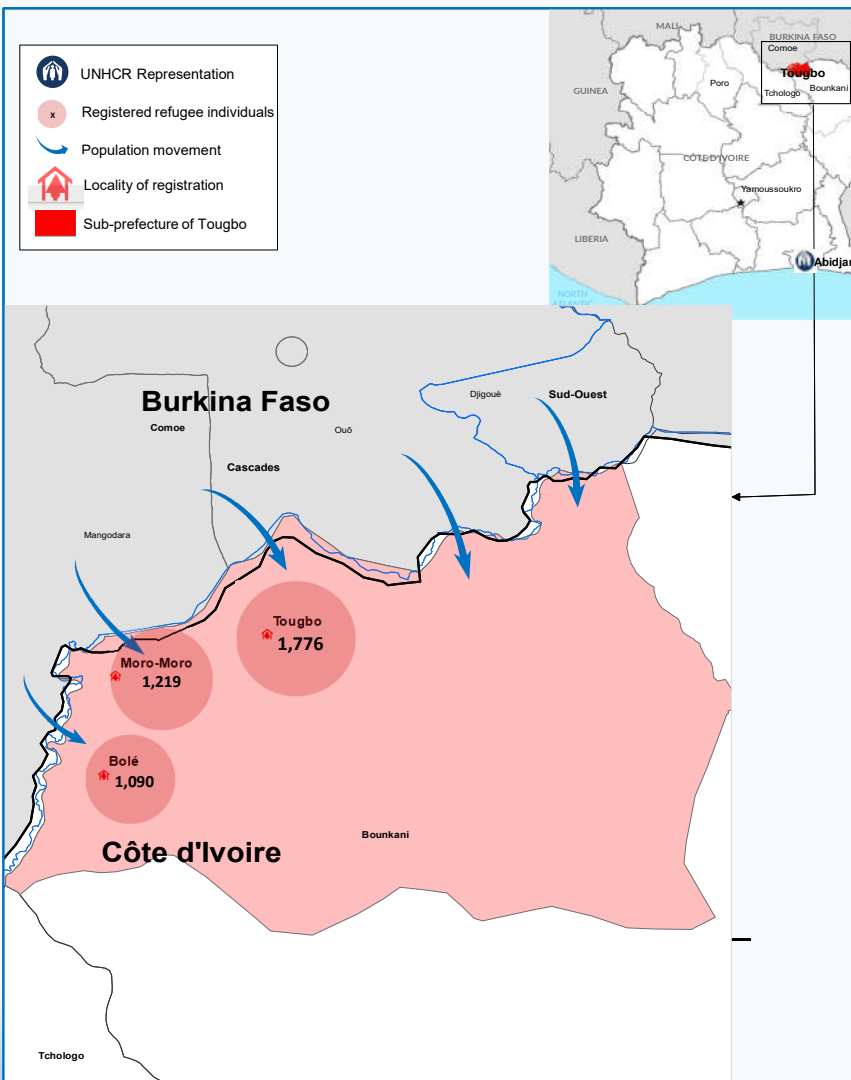

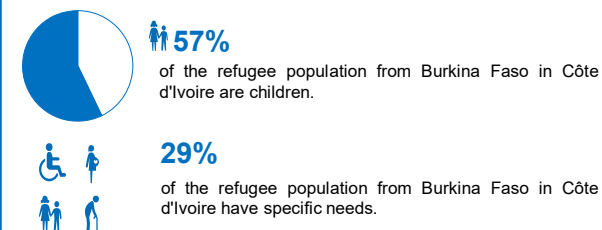

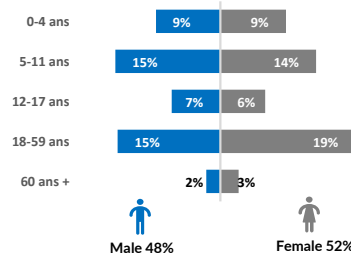

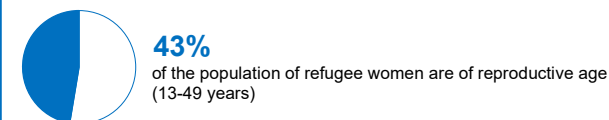
**Population characteristics**
