It will impact the operational activities, as people will have to queue for longer and will have less capacity in common centers. • The lack of provision of warm food will be a challenge. <p>Activity Info:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activity Info is an online data collection tool. • All partners implementing activities as part of the RRP are required to report in AI. • Stefan will temporarily take over the coordination of the AI tool. • Good progress on the 5Ws - more than 800 activities reported. • 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • IA to circulate the report in order to understand which supplies needs should be increased and whether the capacity of volunteers is enough. • Romania is the only country to launch this exercise - important to share the expertise with other countries in the region. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The deadline for the reporting partner to report is the 3rd of next month. • All RRP partners should delegate an AI focal point.
<p>Sectoral updates (targeted, action-oriented, activities / gaps)</p>	<p>Livelihoods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Christian Renson, the newly appointed Livelihoods and Economic Inclusion Officer, joined the meeting for the first time. • There is progress on candidates accessing job search assistance and entering platforms through partners' jobs. <p>Basic Needs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Winterization re-calibration processes are underway and reaching out to the various partners will form a component of that. <p>Cash:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The group is working on generating possible questions for rapid market assessments for winterization. <p>Education:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The goal is the inclusion of children in the Romanian system, which translates into a lot of effort in terms of space, training the teachers, language training, providing education supplies. • One focus of the education working group is to raise issues with the government and local authorities. 	

	<p><u>Health:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HWG work plan under development and meeting with RRP health partners planned. • Aligning work plan with National Action Plan and RRP. • Bilateral meetings were held with three RRP health partners in the past week. <p><u>MHPSS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undergoing recruitment for Ukrainian psychologists to overcome the difficulties in the counseling process. <p><u>Protection:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The development of the training calendar is ongoing. • DRC and NRC have been in contact with the sector leads with the goal to coordinate efforts and be part of the ongoing initiatives. <p><u>PSEA:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Several trainings organized in Northern Romania for government authorities, including police, border police and local public authorities. <p><u>Anti-Trafficking:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Marina Gomez joined the meeting for the first time, as IOM co-lead of the work group. <p><u>IM:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The team passed the first round of reporting in the activity info. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start focusing on the multi-set technique assessment that will also help inform the RRP re-calibration - this would be an inter-agency exercise. • Start revising the protection profiling tool.
