Updated figures and announcements (UNHCR)	<p>Update figures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UNHCR Inter-Agency Coordination and IM are trying to update slides with latest numbers (as of Thursday evenings) as the figures presented on Friday are a few days late. <p>2022 RRP Recalibration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Narrative shared with the region. Focus on linkages to protection and longer-term socio-economic inclusion as reflected in the National Plan of Measures (NAP), linkage between our WGs and Government WGs under the NAP and preparedness for the possibility of receiving more arrivals due to winter. • Regional Office is compiling preparedness narratives from different countries. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Inter-Agency Coordination will share the regional product with the Sector Leads as soon as it is received. • Out of 23 agencies 21 has already provided the budget re-adjustment with only \$22,000 difference in total. • Achievements reported in narratives are not sufficiently reflected in ActivityInfo: • All sector leads/co-leads reported progress in ActivityInfo. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Leads/co-leads to remind WG partners should report on ActivityInfo. • Sector Leads are requested to report against the NAP because the Government is implementing a system/database to track progress against the NAP Measures.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sector Leads are requested to report against the NP using Government’s online excel sheet for August; Inter-Agency is inserting data received through the 5Ws and ActivityInfo - Inter-Agency Coordination team will reach out to the Sector Leads next week to complement data (should the 5Ws and AI be insufficient). • Some RRP targets are much higher than most countries such as: Health including mental health, CASH: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Sector Leads could consider lowering the targets. ○ Sebastiaan will have bilateral meetings with Health and CASH WGs to discuss lowering targest. • RRP Romania to consider developing an Indicator for livelihoods. • Sebastiaan and Stefan will meet with the Sector Leads on indicators and reporting to meet the deadlines as August deadline was not met <p><u>Multi-Sectoral Needs Assessment update:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Last day to provide input on the questionnaire: 09 September. • Data collection will start in the first week of October. <p><u>WGs mailing list:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rozita will send the compiled version of WGs mailing list after the meeting. - Sector Leads will review their WG’s mailing list and provide updates to Rozita by Tuesday 13 September. <p><u>Adolescents and Youth:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The survey is finalized and waiting for the Education Sector Lead to coordinate for the establishment of new sub WG.
