DSU and Madam Turza’s office will review it next week. • The 2023 RRP will be finalized from 7 to 15 December based on the regional and Government’s comments. There may be a need to call for a meeting with the Sector Leads before the finalization. • The date for the working session with the Government is not confirmed yet, it may take place on the week of 5 December. • A briefing session with the Heads of UN agencies on 2023 RRP is planned to take place the week of 12 December to have a RRP steering group. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suggestions for Donor Engagement: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- IA to find an active volunteer embassy to revive the donor briefing sessions which was stopped when the UK Emergency Coordinator left Romanian. 2- To use Refugee Coordination Forum as a platform to brief donors on RRP 3- UNHCR and UNICEF External Relations Units to include RRP briefing in the agenda of regular donor briefing sessions. • Local Coordination Events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - IA organized four events in Suceava (27 October), Maramures (11 November), Satu Mare (16 November) and Cluj (21 November) for partners. Events in Galati and Constanta will take place on 12 and 16 December 2022. Two more events will be done in 2023, locations will be determined later. - Goal of events: support the Government at the national level; to understand partners' activities at the local level; collaborate strategically and addressing issues and improving processes and services. - UNHCR to ensure it does not duplicate existing arrangements, but support and ensure linkages. - Create a space and opportunity for people and organizations to meet, understand the existing arrangements at the national level and how the local arrangements can fall into them, discuss ways and opportunities for collaboration and communication. - GAPS and NEEDS – language, employment, service mapping, ongoing coordination, donations/funds to local organizations. - IA will have 8 locations for networking and following ups through the focal points.
