


VERIFIED IDP SITES IN GARBAHAAREY AS OF DECEMBER 2022



Map of verified IDP sites in Garbahaarey - December 2022


Assessment overview

IDP site verification exercise was conducted in Garbahaarey in December 2022 by ACTED, GEWDO, SADO, Mercy Corps, NCA, SEDHURO and Unicef.

16 IDP sites were identified hosting 4,325 households or 27,832 individuals. Compared to the site DSA V, there was an increase in 12 IDP Sites, 3,324 households and 22,994 individuals.

People living with disability

Using the washington group disability questions, statistics of people living with disabilities were

830 (2.98%)

169 (50% Female) have difficulty with seeing (even wearing glasses)

148 (50% Female) have difficulty with hearing (even using a hearing aid)

121 (50% Female) have difficulty with communicating and/or understanding

168 (46% Female) have difficulty with walking and/or climbing stairs

104 (54% Female) have difficulty with dressing and/or washing

120 (57% Female) have difficulty with remembering/concentrating

Eviction Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of eviction. Several factors were put into consideration such as IDP site tenure, type of agreements in place and whether an eviction notice has been issued recently.

6.25% of IDP sites have been

Flood Risk Mapping

IDP sites were assessed based on their risk of flooding.
