Updating the SOP at PBS with all actors.</p>	<p><b>UNHCR Field Team – Karina Volokh</b></p> <p>The meeting started with a welcome to all present and updates from UNHCR:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On 11 January, the Field team received 8 people transported by Be an Angel at PBS. They stayed until they ate and then left for Chisinau.</li> <li>• On 12 January, the Field team received 6 people at PBS transported by Be an Angel. <p>2. Update on recent developments that took place at PBS.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• On 12 January, electricity went out in PBS partially due to a burned-out transformer. The electrician installed a new transformer and electricity was restored in PBS.</li><li>• On 12 January, the Field team visited the Social Assistance Directorate of Stefan Voda to sign the necessary documents to begin the distribution of NFIs to refugees and host communities living in the district.</li><li>• UNHCR winterization program is continuing at Palanca Bus Station through ACTED. The distribution of NFIs at the PBS is proceeding well and every Friday the Field team verifies the quantity distributed with partner ACTED.</li><li>• On 17 January, 5 containers (4 for offices and 1 for storage) have been delivered and donated to IGSU tent camp and successfully installed.</li><li>• Today, the Field team together with CDA and the Mayor of Palanca had a meeting with the IRC at the Municipality of Palanca and talked about a project IRC want to implement.</li><li>• Also today, the Field team received a visit from IFRC and IOM staff at PBS. The purpose of the visit was to see the territory and all the work done at PBS.</li><li>• A kind request to all the organization from PBS, in order to keep the bus station clean, for tomorrow 19<sup>th</sup> January to organize with all staff, to clean up the whole area and thow away the waste.</li></ul>	
<p>3. General updates from all humanitarian actors at PBS.</p>	<p><i>Updates from humanitarian actors present at PBS:</i></p> <p><b>ACTED:</b> No major changes, it's operating as usual during the reporting period a total of 88 persons were transported on the territory of Moldova. The winterization programme continues.</p>	



**ISRAAID:** No major changes, it's operating as usual, have provided services for 43 children, 45 adults and continue to distribute non-food items such as hygiene kits and clothes.

**IOM:** The work is going on as usual, Vitalii (our colleague) was delegated to Otaci for a short period of time, but now he is already back in Palanca. The number of beneficiaries is low lately.

During the reporting period, 19 people were transported to Iasi, but since 1 January, 99 people have been transported to Husi.

IOM informs us of the law that the Romanian authorities intend to implement. According to this law, for the beneficiaries who will stay in Romania for more than 5 days the transport within the country will be free of charge and for those who will stay less than 5 days it will be on payment. Already now, some transportations are charged for people arriving from Ukraine.

**ACR.MD:** Are no longer provide food at customs, there is another organization that support the BCP with food.

The responsibilities of the PBS and the focal point of the ACR will be given to Nicolai, the new colleague from ACR 068230273.

**Blue Dot:** Have started work at Sculeni customs and continue to work at the Airport. At PBS they provided services to 30 children and 24 adults.

**CDA:** Work is proceeding without reportable incidents, 15 people have been legally advised.

**UNFPA:** Offer hygienic kits and personalized kits for women. It is activated according to the plan and psychological assistance is offered at PBS. They also continue to activate the mobile team in the villages. Work continues at the railway station in Chisinau.



	<p><b>Intersos:</b> There are no updates, they continue to offer psycho-social assistance and first aid in case of need.</p> <p><b>Solidarites International (online):</b> Continue to provide WASH services, also next week they are planning to do disinfection work at the tented camp. The winterization programme continues.</p> <p><b>Sean Sager UNHCR (online):</b> Informs that temporary protection is already available and that training is to be done in the field on information on the mechanics and methods of applying temporary protection.</p>
