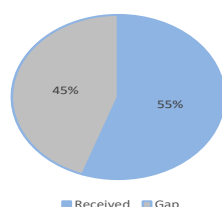

Funding Status (Refugee component Including Covid)

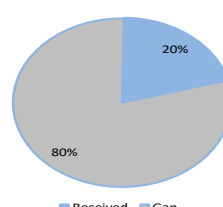

Funding Status (Resilience component)

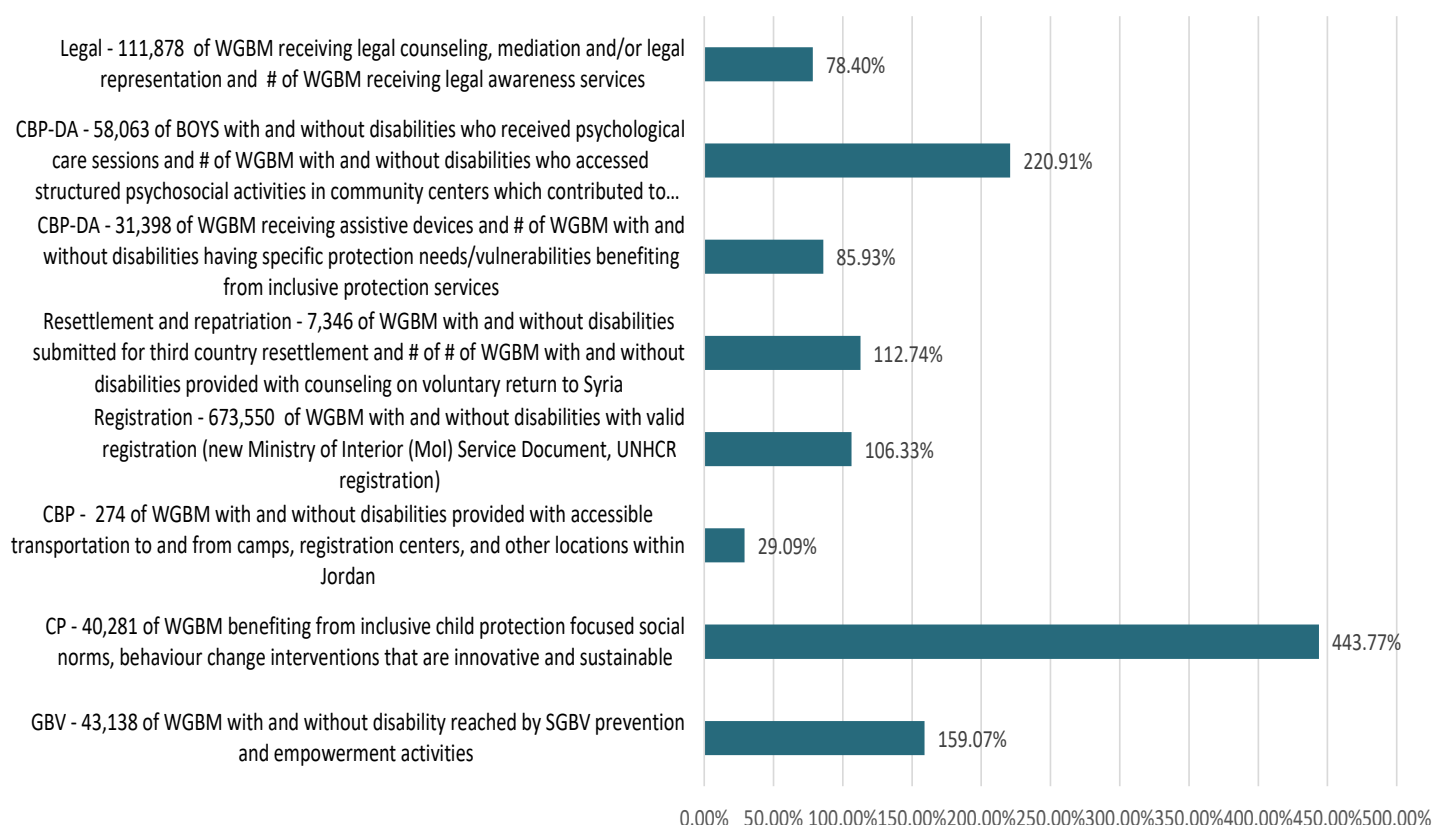

Progress against Targets: Sector Priority Indicators

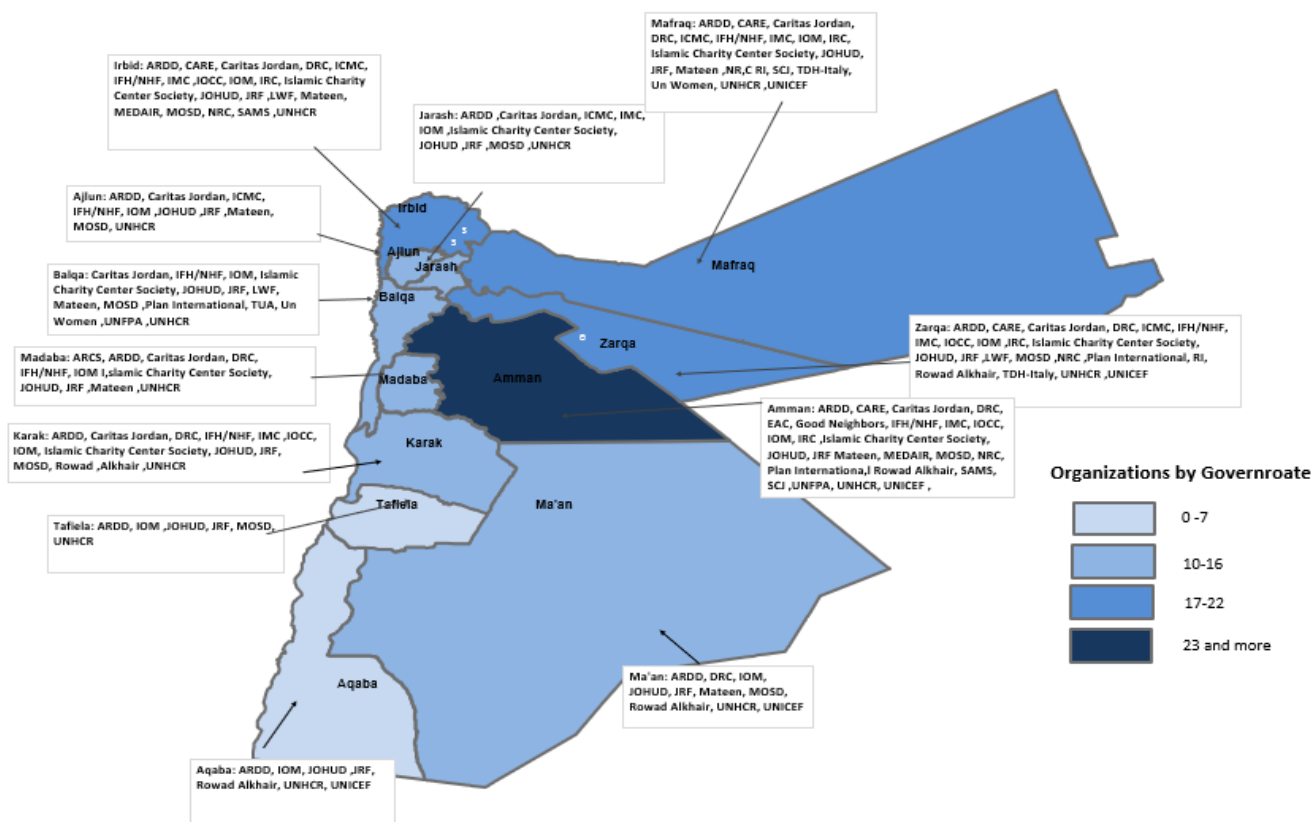
