Methodology

- Findings representative for 4 geographical zones: North, Center, South, and Chisinau;
- Random sampling based upon the data on registration for Temporary Protection;
- Focused only on refugees without stratification between RACs and outside

Timeline

- Data collection: tentatively May 2023;
- Data processing: June 2023;
- Reporting: July 2023

- Sector-specific presentations;

- Report

Methodology

- Findings representative for 4 geographical zones: North, Center, South, and Chisinau;
- Mixed-method for data collection: face-to-face interviews, focus groups, key informants' interviews, connectivity data.
- Comparative study of socio-economic situation between refugees and hosting HHs

Methodology

- Purposive sampling with defined sample size per location
- **Key**
Locations: Aid distribution /information points; Protection Desks, NGO offices (90% of all surveys); Cash enrollment centers, community service centers, Communities (mobile teams)

- Monthly factsheet refresher;
- Quarterly Protection Brief production

RAC Monitoring

Methodology

- Continuing with no change from 2022
- KIIs with RAC managers on occupancy, demographics and needs in Refugee Accommodation Centers

Timeline

- Occupancy and demographics data collection twice a week
- Detailed needs data collection twice a month
- Factsheet once a month

Outputs

- Occupancy and demographics dataset
- Needs dataset
- Monthly factsheet

Area Monitoring

Methodology

- KIIs with local authorities on the number of refugees residing in an area

Timeline

- Every two months

Outputs

- Dataset on known refugee population per Raion (in the Inter-Agency SharePoint)

- Builds upon the methodology of the 1st ABA done in Moldova in 2022.
- Tentatively a focus on Anenii Noi
- Mixed-method data collection with focus on the multi-sectoral needs of refugees and the local population
