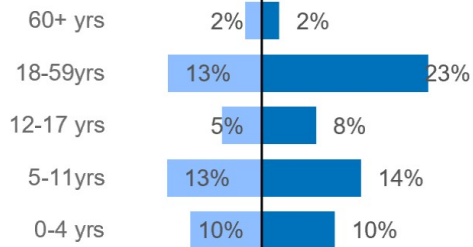

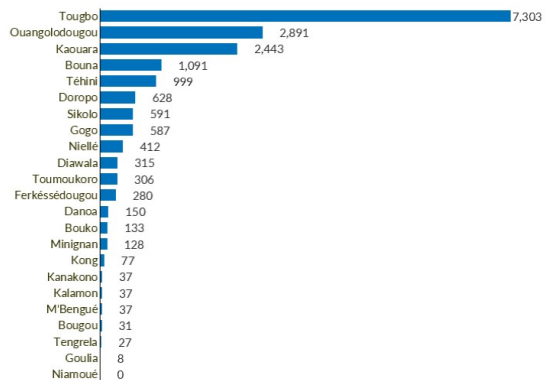

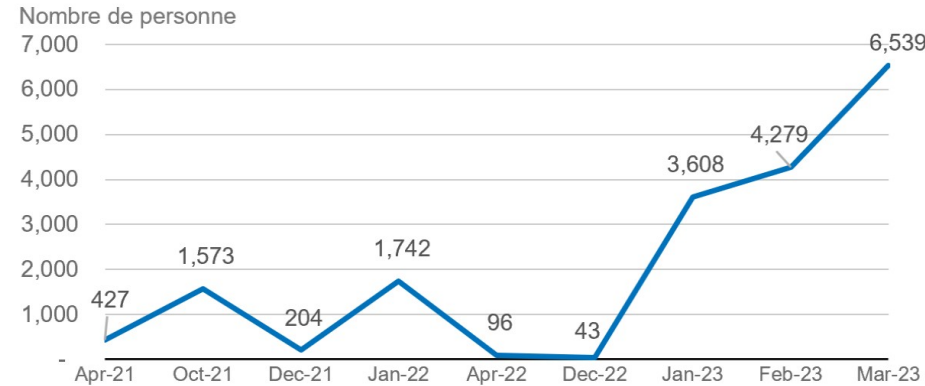

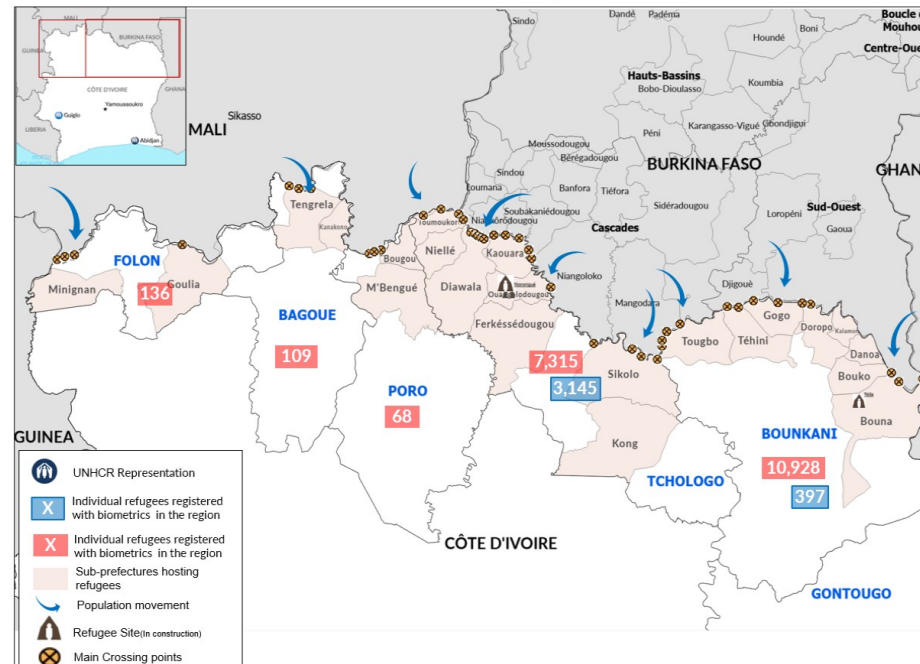

Situation Map

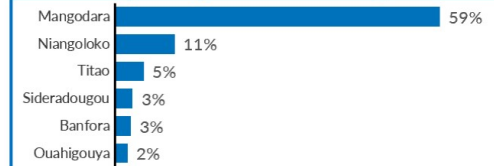

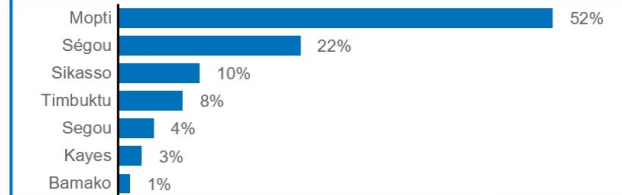
Country of Origin of registered refugees*



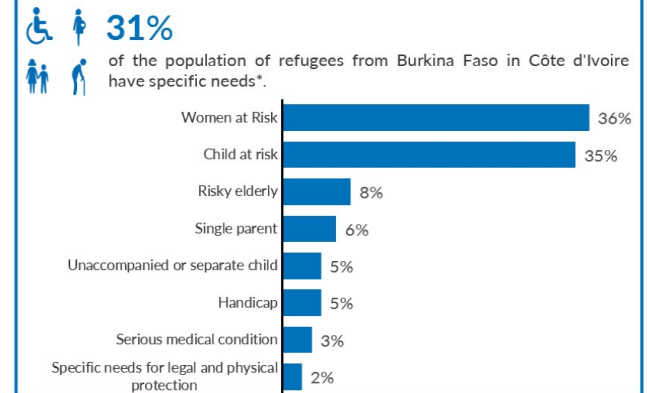
Principal Departments of origin in Burkina Faso
