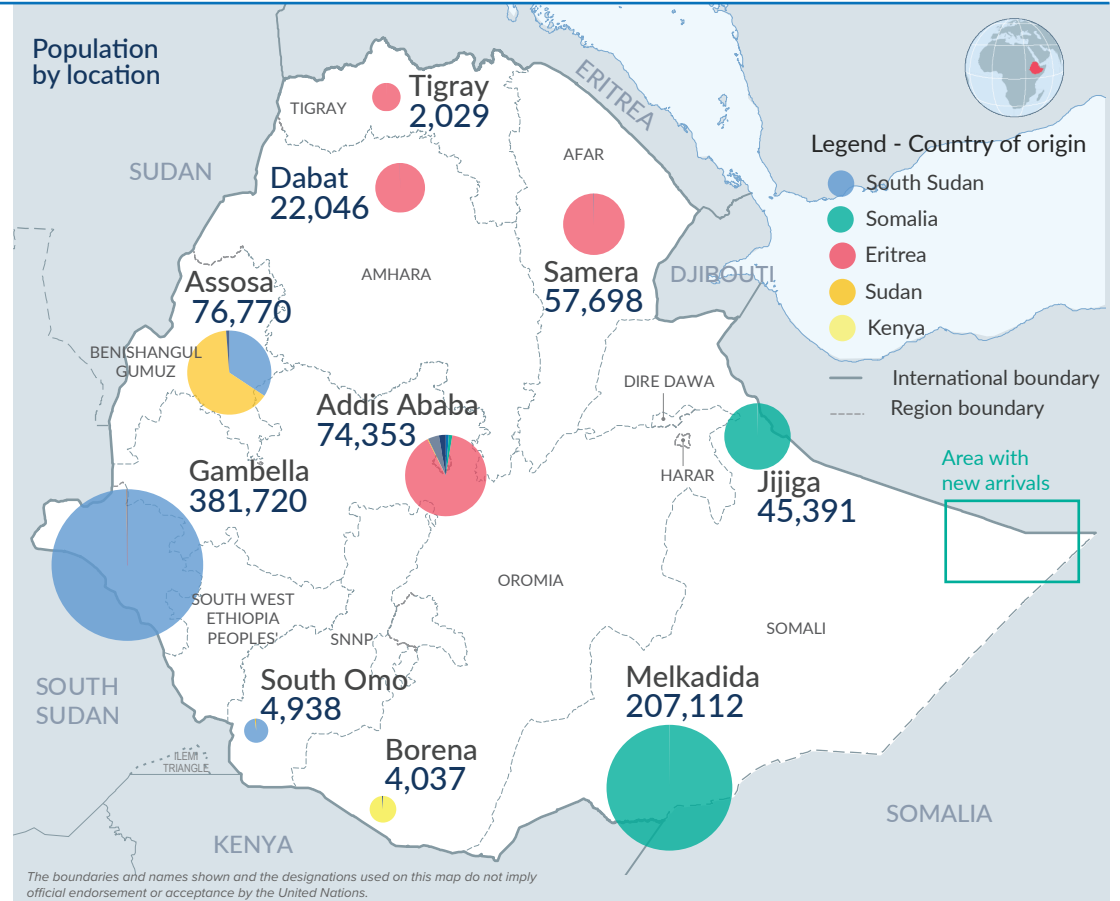

Population by type of accommodation

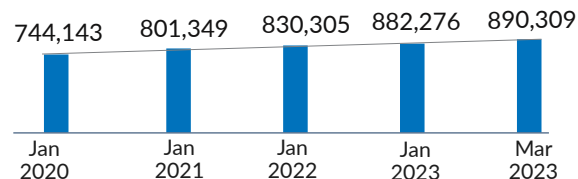

Total population trend



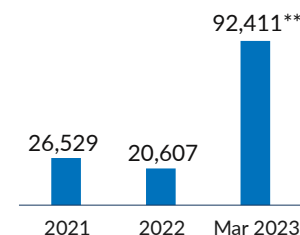
Population by period of arrival
