Updates & Achievements

- **WHO** spoke about the legislative proposal that Ukrainian psychologists can practice in Romania in the context that they may have beneficiaries from Ukraine. The proposed EGO was sent from M. Turza's office to the College of Psychologists for a point of view. WHO will inform partners of the progress of this process.
- **WHO** presented the action points from the last meeting, stating that in relation to the issues of a place where humanitarian mental health announcements can be collected, there is now a project under discussion to develop a Roster of Ukrainian-speaking candidates who are mental health specialists, especially psychologists who can be hired by interested organizations. This project proposal is being carried out in collaboration with IOM and Jobs for Ukraine.
- **Estuar Foundation** reported on their sexual exploitation and abuse prevention program with Project Hope.
- **ACF** is conducting needs assessments to identify further needs in terms of both FSL and the MHPS assistance and preparing for a possible contingency. In other terms, with their partner in Iasi, Parentis they have some ongoing initiatives for Christmas, that will be shared with the group for an online auction about artworks created by beneficiaries.
- **Save the Children** is planning to have staff capacity building on PFA for children in Galati and Bucharest and next year they are planning to offer PFA for children, a training and MHPS programme called Team up for teachers.
- **Project Hope** is providing basic PFA activities and also specialised consultation and they are providing also referrals in the cases where is needed they are working in Bucharest, Radau'i ;i Soncuta Mare. They are also providing PS intervention as PFA and psychological sessions. Also medical intervention and primary care and support for medical check-ups on a test. And they will be based in the border to have a reception centre providing services as transportation to take the people for the centres of accommodation. Also with PFA basic needs providing a support for basic needs and clothes, food and this kind of things. And later when the people is organised and the in Bucharest in the other centre they will receive a language lessons.

- It remains a challenge to identify psychologists of different specialties in different parts of the country.
