Summary of discussions and agreements/ action points

1. Follow up on "Amare Amala" week, International Roma Day Cristina Sîrbu, Support Head of Mission, INTERSOS	Cristina Sîrbu showed a presentation giving an overview on "Amare Amala" Week organized in occasion of Roma International Day.
Elena Sirbu, President, Roma Women Platform Romni Marin Alla, CEO, "Roma Voice" Coalition	Elena Sirbu mention that many Roma people do not understand the necessity of TP. Therefore, they are not properly informed about rights and responsibilities and about the changes that will occur. She asked the partners to prepare a shared document with all the information that should be given to the refugees, as well as all the updates on this subject. We should also take into account Transnistria region, as they are asked to present not only their ID passport by also a foreign passport to access the cash assistance.
Elena Sirbu, President, Roma Women Platform Romni	Marin Alla said that there should be found some Transnistrian affiliates who will be a Partner of Roma Task Force, but with the residence in Transnistria in order to have a common picture of the real needs of Roma people in that region. Alla Marin mentioned that in the refugee centers there are a few people would like to apply for Temporary Protection, as they are not informed and there and that they consider that there are too many documents to be presented.
	The number of the organization offering medical assistance and humanitarian aid decreased, but Roma refugees are still in need of this kind of assistance. Many organizations are offering aid for those who register for Temporary Protection, which is a big challenge for Roma refugees. Elena Sirbu expressed the desire of a better collaboration between Roma refugees, public authorities and international organizations to facilitate the access to the aid, and solving any other issues that occurs.

The concerts come as a thank you from the Roma refugees for being welcomed in the village/ city they are located now. There was advised that simultaneously with the concerts to be organized information campaigns on Temporary protection. These cultural events will be the beginning of Roma raising awareness events.
