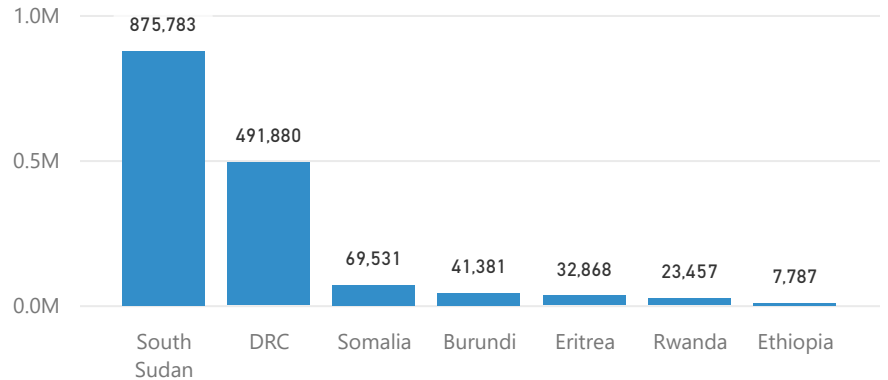

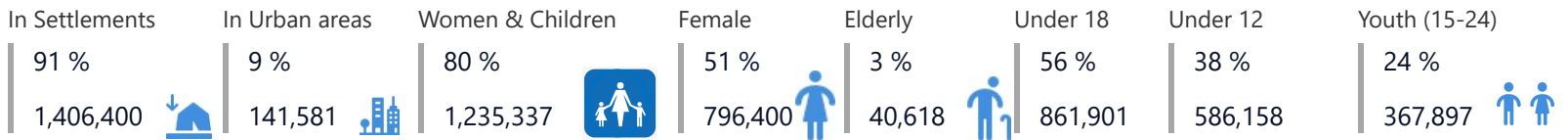

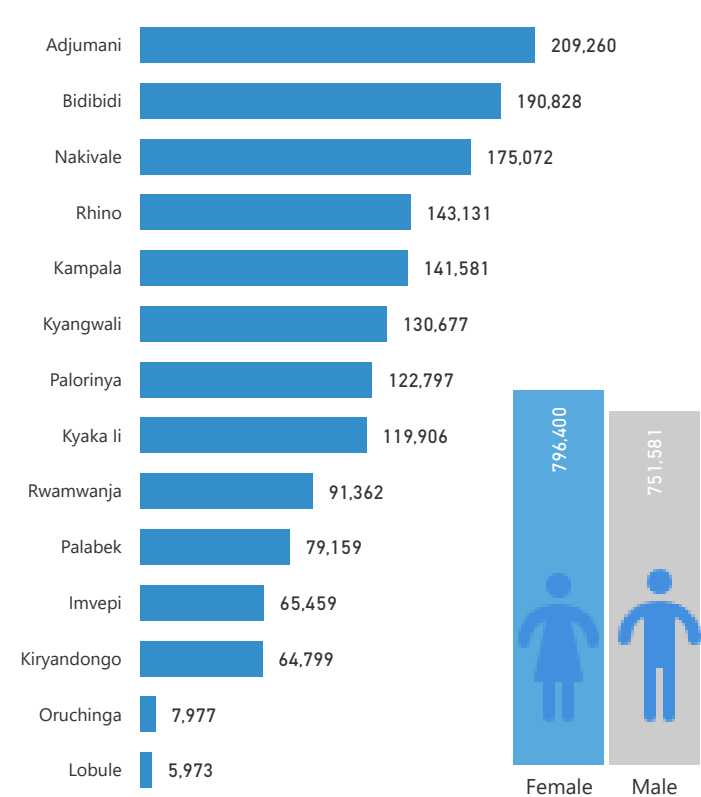
Top 7 Countries of Origin



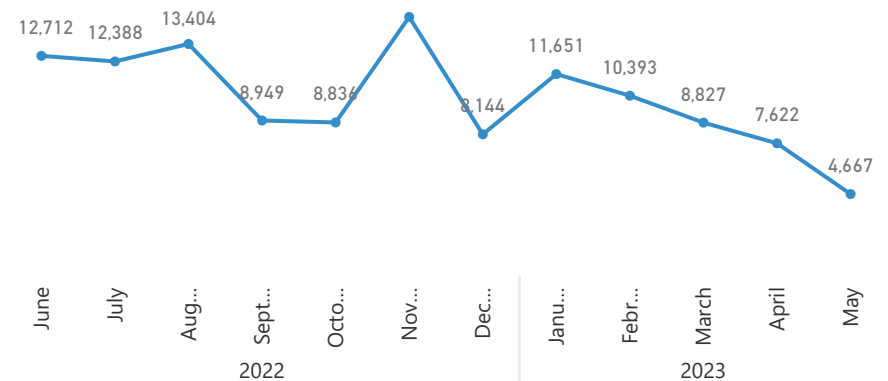
Population Distribution



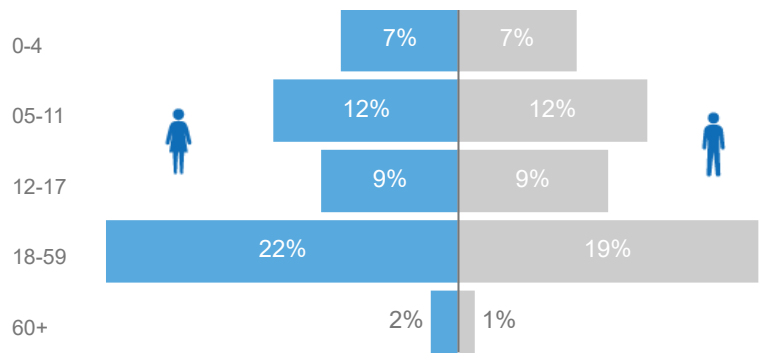
Population by Location

Age & Gender Breakdown



Since the start of 2023, more than 54,500 new arrivals and new births 5,000 have been registered across the settlements and urban locations in Uganda. Close to 42% of new arrivals originate from South Sudan, and 20% from the DR Congo. New arrivals are hosted mainly in Nakivale, Palabek, Rhino, and Rwamwanja settlements, but a small number have chosen to stay in urban Kampala. Continuous registration activities during this month recorded a decrease of 600 individuals in the population for reasons of protracted absence/No Show, death and spontaneous departure. 97% of the 1,547,981 refugees and asylum-seekers in Uganda are refugees. The people with and for whom we work in Uganda reside mostly in settlements (91%), and are comprised of 82% Women and Children, 52% Women and Girls, 3% elderly, and 24% youths. Cash and food assistance is delivered on a monthly basis to 97% of the population who are eligible.

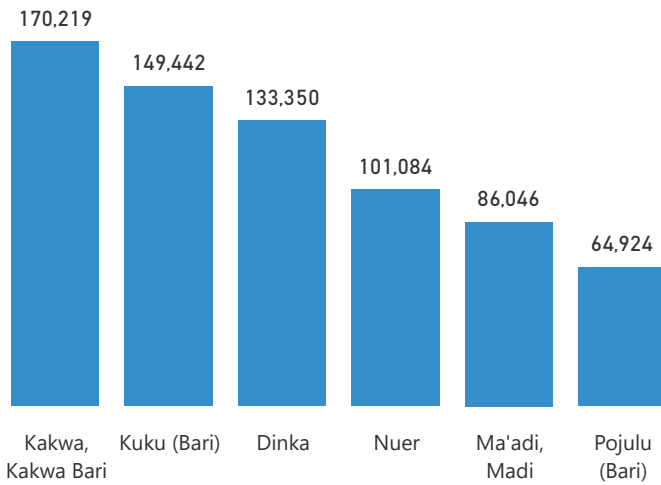

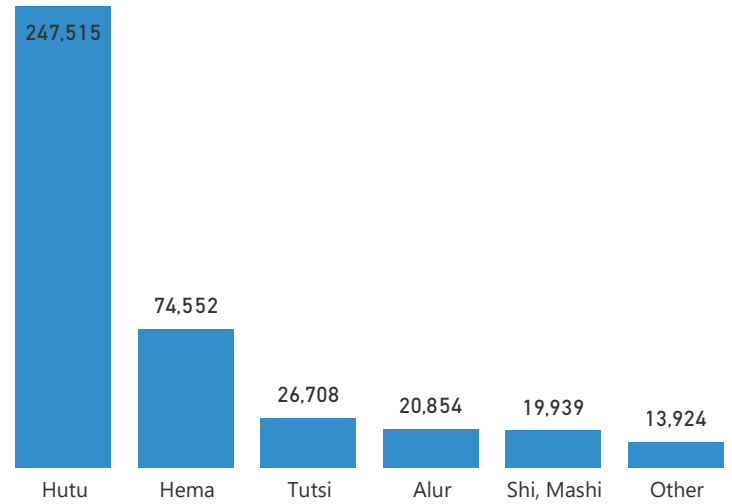

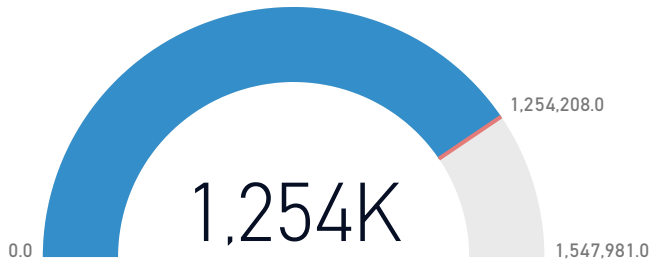
Top 6 South Sudanese Ethnicities



Top 6 Congolese Ethnicities



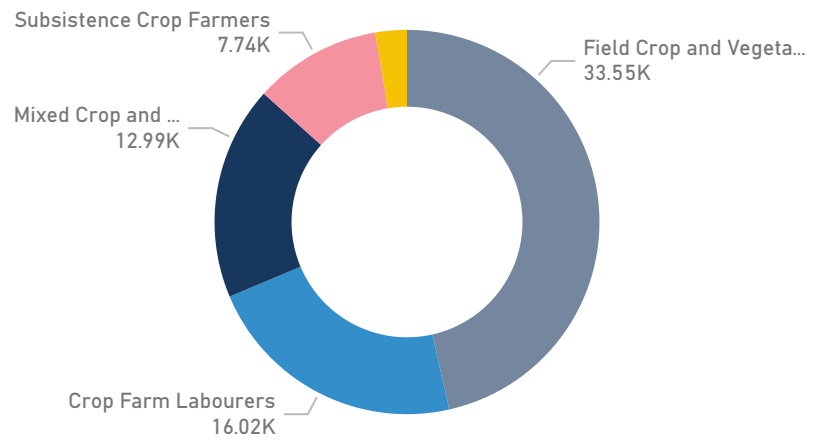
Biometric Enrolment



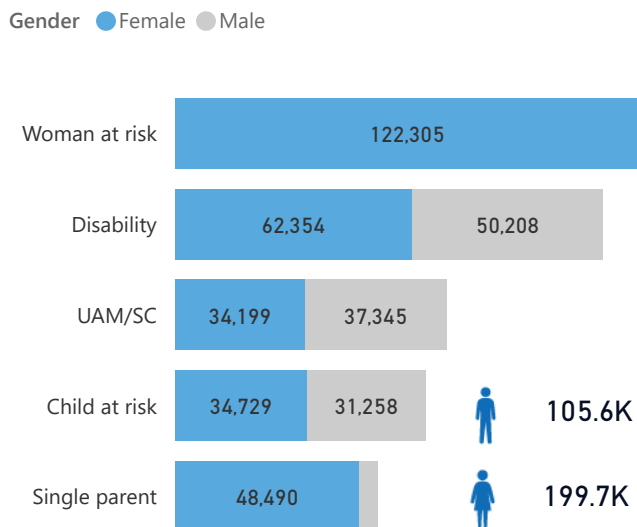
Biometric Enrolment by Gender
