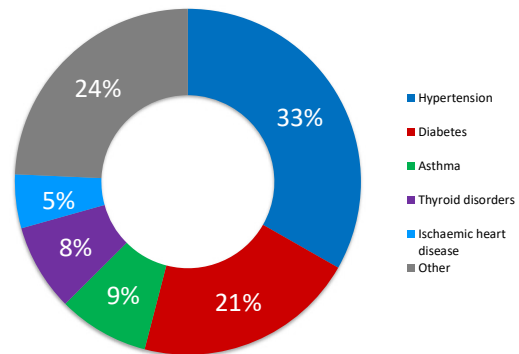

### Chronic health conditions (%)

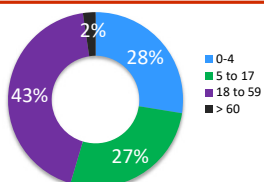

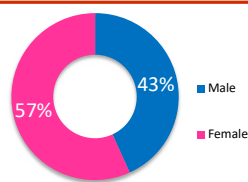

by gender

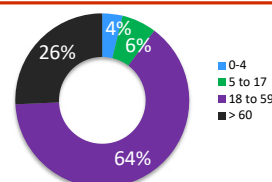

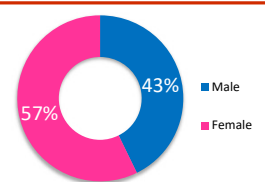

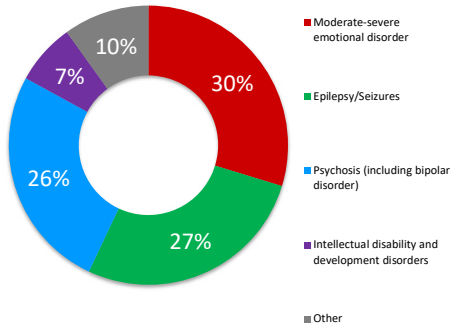

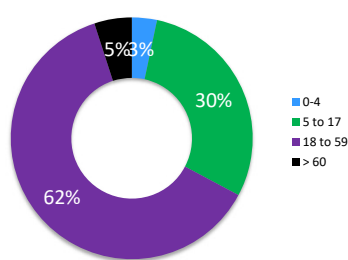

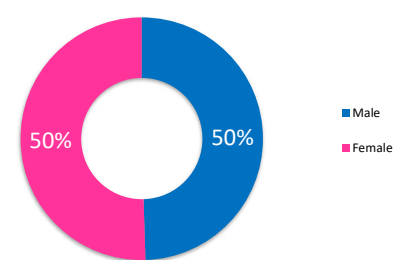
### By cause



### By age

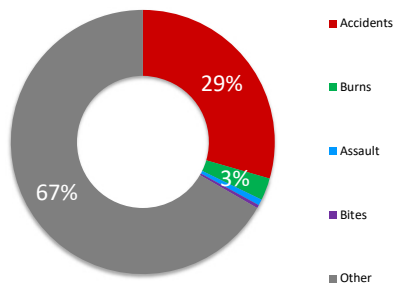

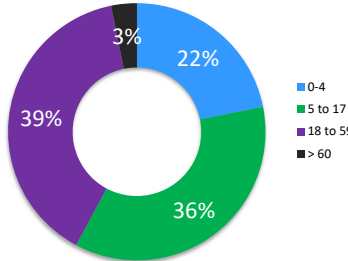

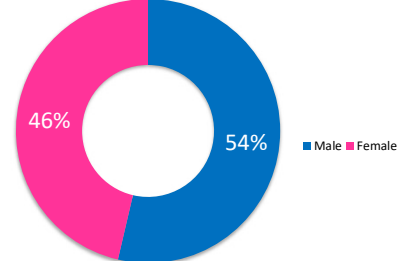
