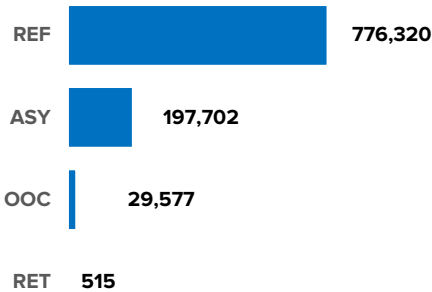
FORCIBLY DISPLACED PEOPLE & RETURNEES¹

As a result of persecution, conflict, violence, human rights violations, or events seriously disturbing public order.



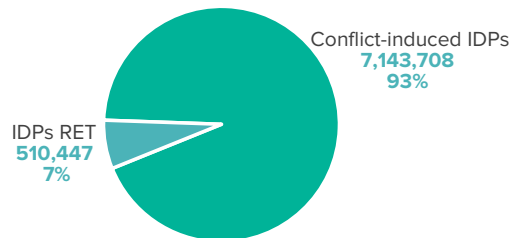

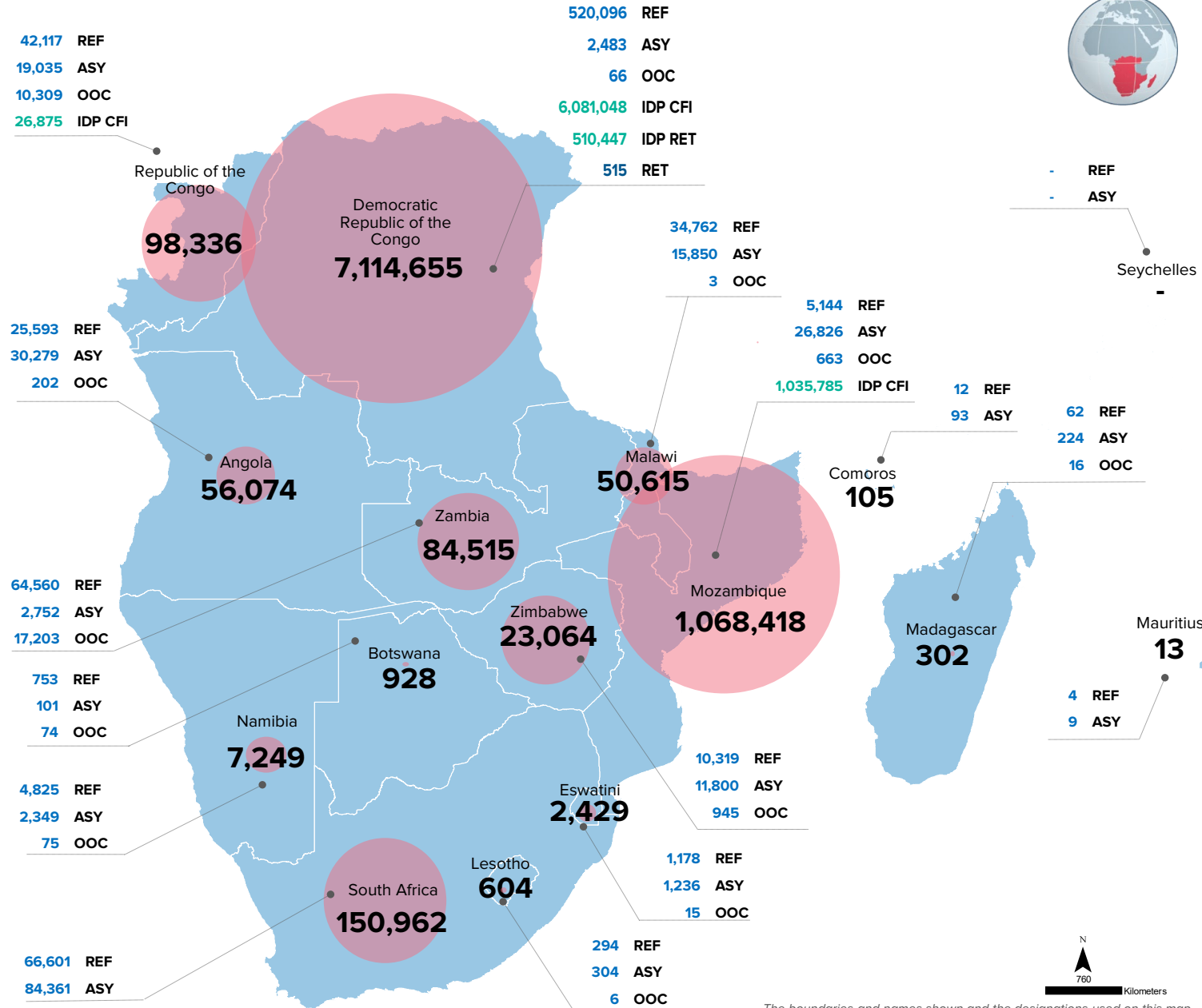
