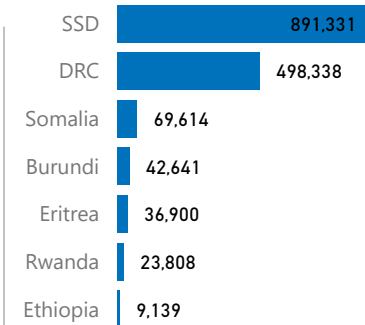

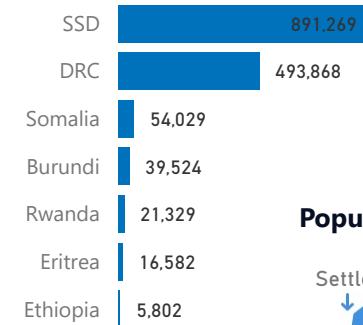

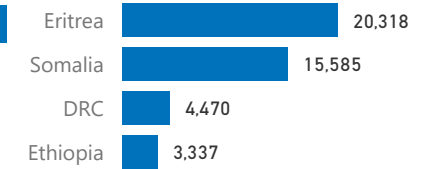
Top 7 Countries of Origin



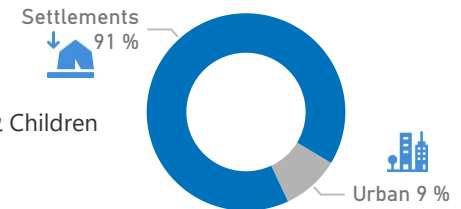
Top 7 Refugee Population



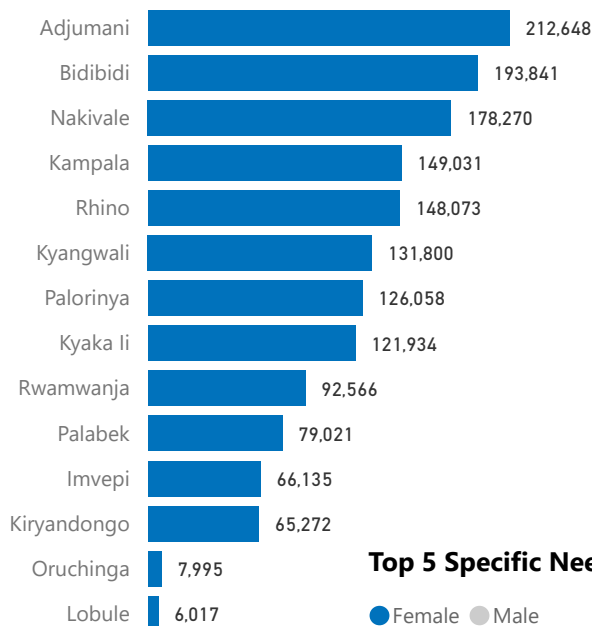
Top 4 Asylum Seeker Population



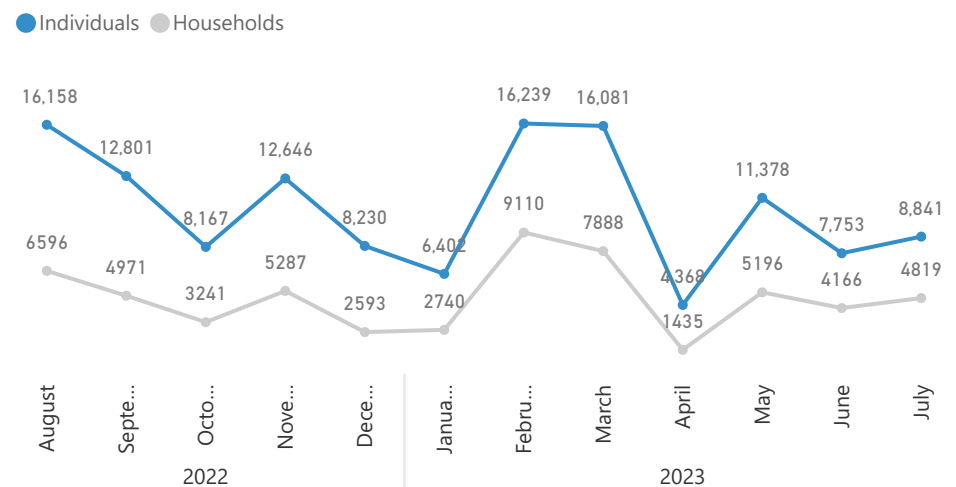
Population Distribution



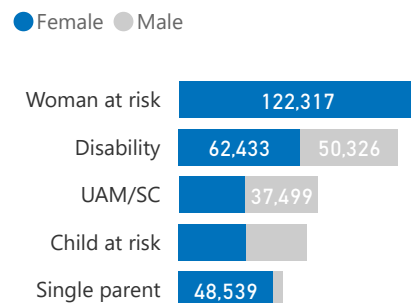
Population per settlement



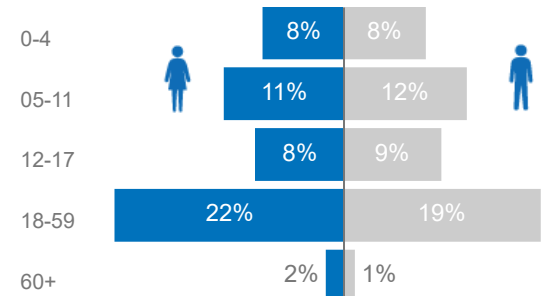
New registration over last 12 months

Age & Gender Breakdown



Since the start of 2023, more than 71,000 individuals (including 17,900 new birth) have been registered across the settlements and urban locations in Uganda. Close to 40% of new arrivals originate from South Sudan, and 20% from the DR Congo. New arrivals are hosted mainly in Nakivale, Palabek, Palorinya, and Rhino settlements, but a small number have chosen to stay in urban Kampala. Verification grace period activities continued this month in 5 settlements (Adjumani, Bidibidi, Palabek, Palorinya, and Rhino) for refugees/asylum-seekers who missed the 2021-2022 verification and individual profiling exercise. So far 12,853 individuals have been verified. During the month, continuous registration activities recorded a decrease of 1,766 in the population for reasons of protracted absence/No Show, death, and spontaneous departure.

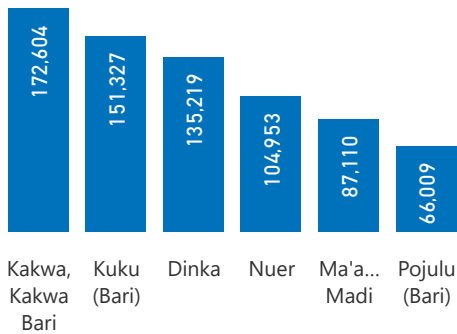

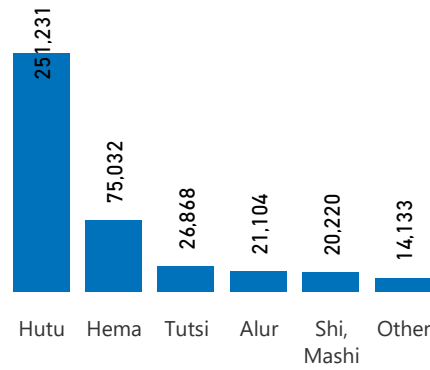

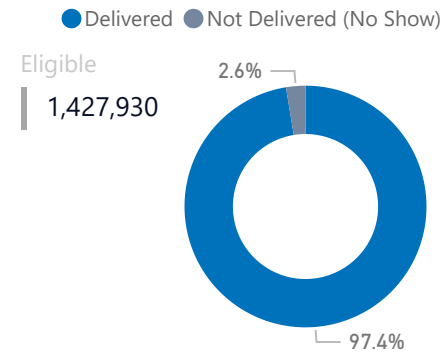
Top 6 South Sudanese Ethnicities

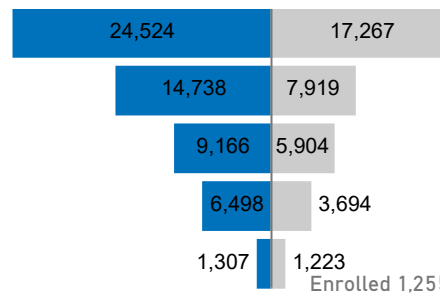

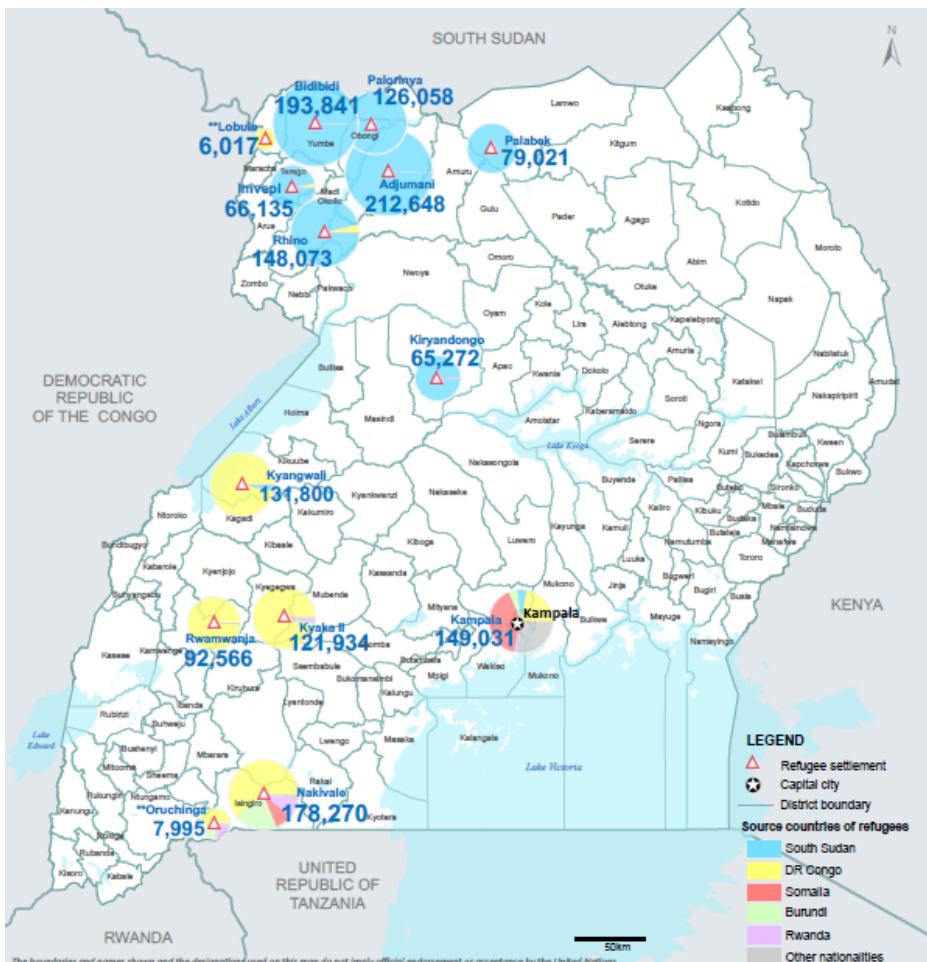
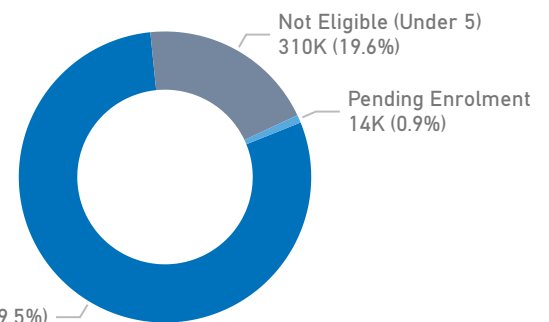
