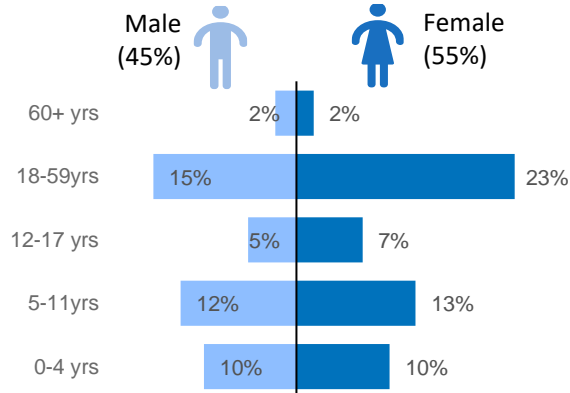

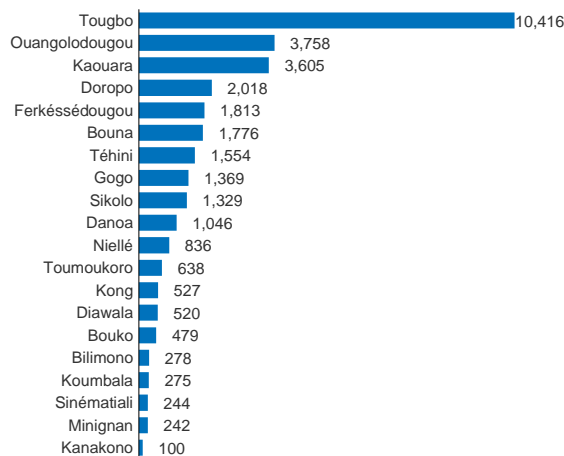

Age and Gender Breakdown*



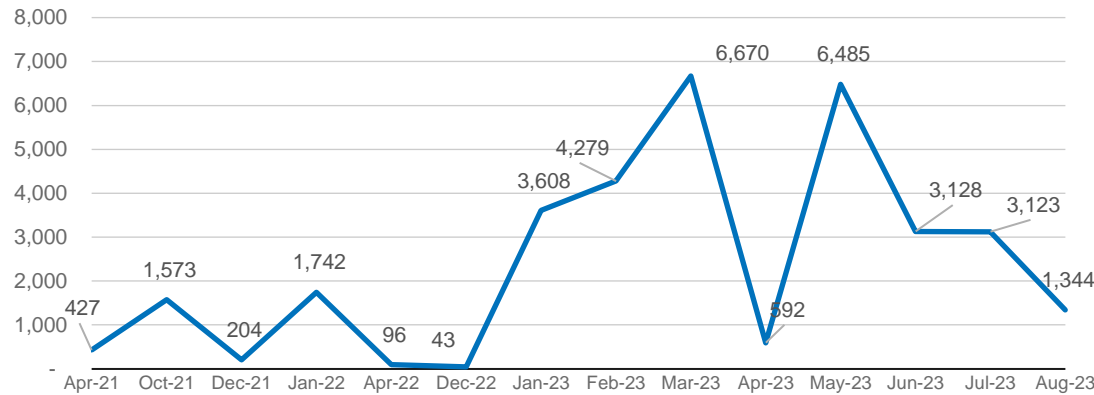
Sub-prefectures hosting asylum seekers



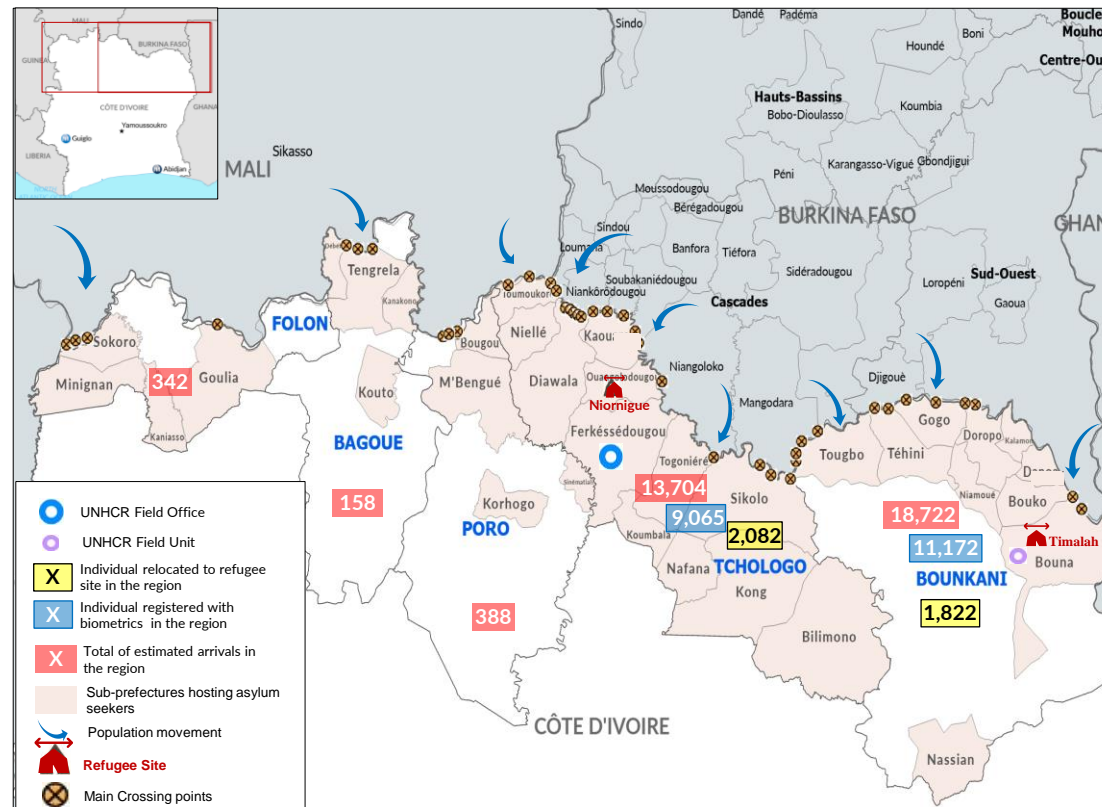

Situation Map

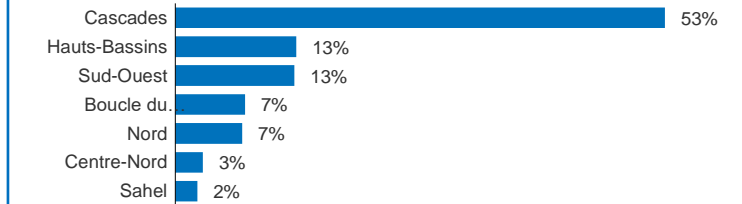

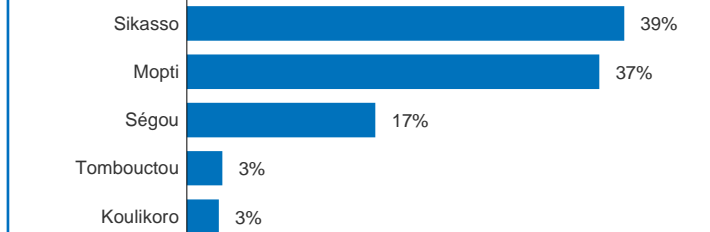
Country of Origin of registered asylum seekers



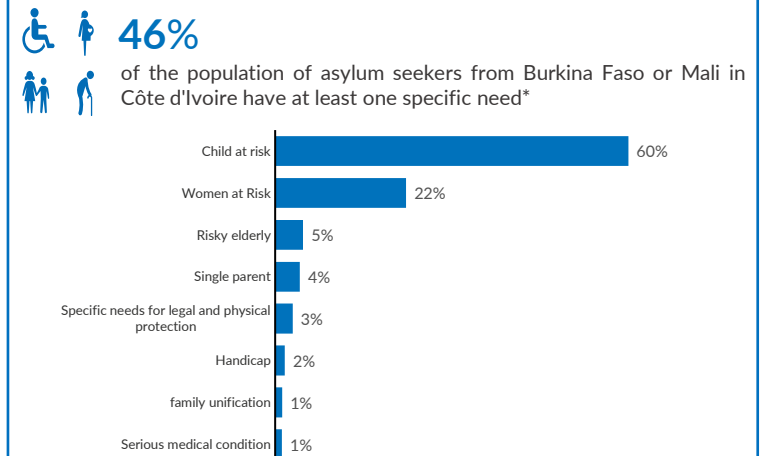
Principal regions of origin in Burkina Faso
