Food Items

- Hot meals in the RACs, through catering
- Hot meals in RACs through food vouchers for on site cooking
- Food packages

Non-food Items

- Institutional hygiene kits
- Essential dignity packs at arrival

Cash Vouchers & Transfers

- Hygiene items vouchers as direct support to refugees distributed to most at risk refugees who are not staying in refugee accommodation centres.

Protection Work - MHPSS

- 12 Community Safe Spaces in refuges accommodations centres where refugees are residing and the refugees living in communities and host families.
- Referral support to health care and other services for homebound older people
- Assistive Products to refugees on poor mobility and/or disability
- Outreach programme of support to provide basic social care service to homebound in their homes and RACs
- Protection and inclusion support including psychosocial support, building links with the community, and sharing of accessible information on services available

SAFE COMMUNITY SPACE - the place where elderly refugees and locals can come together and have access to psychosocial and legal support from a team of experts. It will also is a space where older people can meet to provide peer support.







Humanitarian program activities June 2023- March 2024

- Type of support provided:
 - Multipurpose cash (300 \$ per beneficiary),
 - Winter cash (90\$ per beneficiary),
 - Food and hygiene packages,
 - Clothes for the cold period
 - Medical vouchers
 - Assistive devices
 - MHPSS activities (12 CSS)
 - 27 RACs provided with 3 meals per day.
- Project implementation areas: Cahul, Taraclia/Valea Perjei, Ungheni, Singerei, Criuleni, Stefan Voda/Tudora, Chisinau, Soroca.

Older people refugees' challenges

- Lack of acces to a specialist suitable for a medical condition (cardiologist, diabetilogist);
- Dificulties in accessing information on medical services and filling in the forms and documentation from authorities;
- Lack of financial resources- difficulties in paying the rent, utilities, the basic household products, food and personal care products;
- Inaccessible infrastructure they need assistive devices products.
