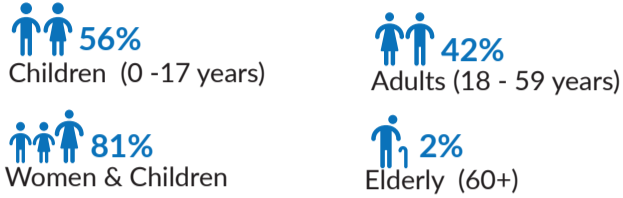


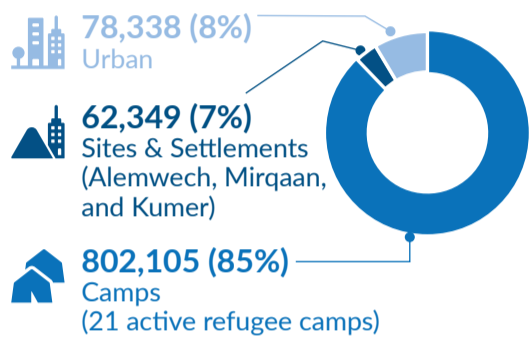

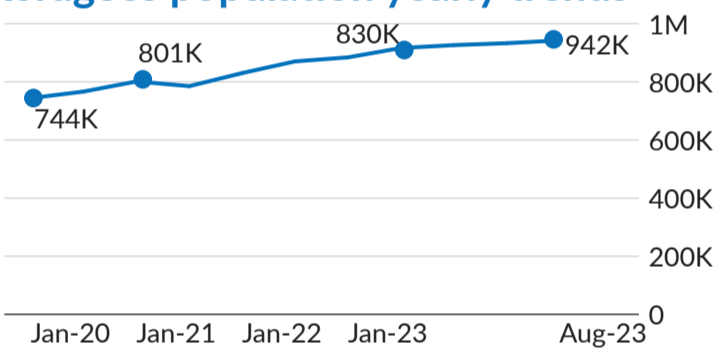
Refugee age-gender breakdown



Refugee population distribution



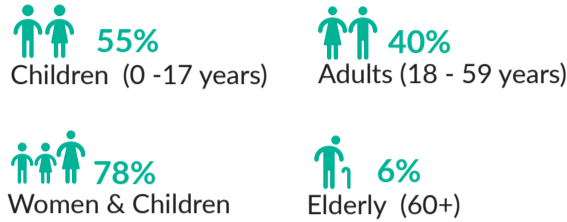
Refugees population yearly trends



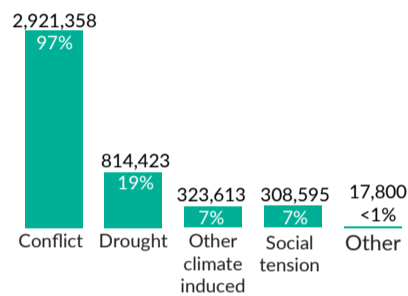

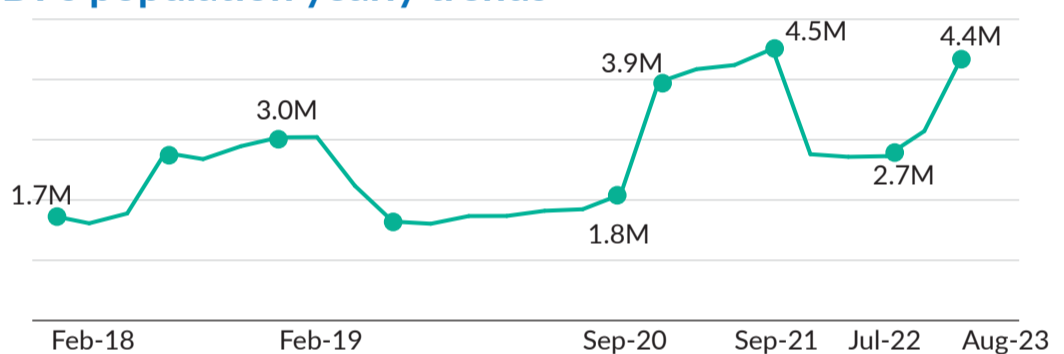
IDPs age-gender breakdown
