Methodological Guidance Note – GBV

R4.2. # of humanitarian response actors and government personnel trained on GBV Prevention, Response, and Risk Mitigation Measures

Objective: This methodology note aligns key humanitarian indicators across corporate planning and reporting processes at all agencies and organizations engaged in the implementation, monitoring, and reporting of the Refugee Response Plan (RRP). Results should be interpreted, recorded, and reported in the same way across the different planning and reporting platforms to ensure:

- Standard and comparable definitions of key humanitarian indicators at country, regional and global levels.
- External reporting of country, regional and global results is harmonized.

This methodology note provides guidance on the tracking and aggregation of data reported by all operations for the indicator on the number of participants trained on Gender Based Violence (GBV) Prevention, Response, and Risk Mitigation Measures through RRP-supported programmes.

NB: The unit of measurement of the RRP indicator is a number.

Participants who received training on GBV may include staff and associates of national, regional and/or local authorities, and staff and associates of international and national non-governmental organizations, of UN agencies, as well as crisis-affected community members, among others.

Training on GBV knowledge is not limited to staff and associates working in the GBV sector and delivering specialized GBV services. It may also be provided to staff and associates working in other sectors who are working with those affected by GBV and in need of protection. Consequently, participants trained on GBV in other sectors should also be counted under this indicator.

Commonly reported activities include:

of staff from humanitarian organisations trained on GBV Prevention, Response, and Risk Mitigation Measures

of staff from partner organisations trained on GBV Prevention, Response, and Risk Mitigation Measures

of government, civil society and other stakeholders trained on GBV Prevention, Response, and Risk Mitigation Measures

Excluded from this figure: It will exclude training of health care workers because it is counted in # health care workers trained. Mass information or awareness raising campaigns utilizing online

platforms, posters, recorded messages, radio etc. to convey GBV related information to entire camps, settlements, urban or other populations of concern should not be counted under this indicator.

Method of Calculation

Number: Count the total number of participants who were trained on GBV through RRP-supported programming during the reporting period (Jan – Dec 2024).

Data sources:

The data sources at the country level include agencies' humanitarian performance monitoring, data from records and reports of training partners, etc.

Data disaggregation:

It is recommended to disaggregate the indicator at country level by the different types of participants and by geographic location (if relevant).
