WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of displaced people slightly decreased from 541,100 last week to 538,500 this week.

In Kayin State, 63 IDPs from Kawkareik were displaced as a secondary displacement to Hpa-An Township, and 154 IDPs from Kyainseikgyi Township were displaced within the same Township due to the intensified fighting in the area.

In Mon State, 2,698 IDPs returned to their place of origin in Billin Township in the first week of October.

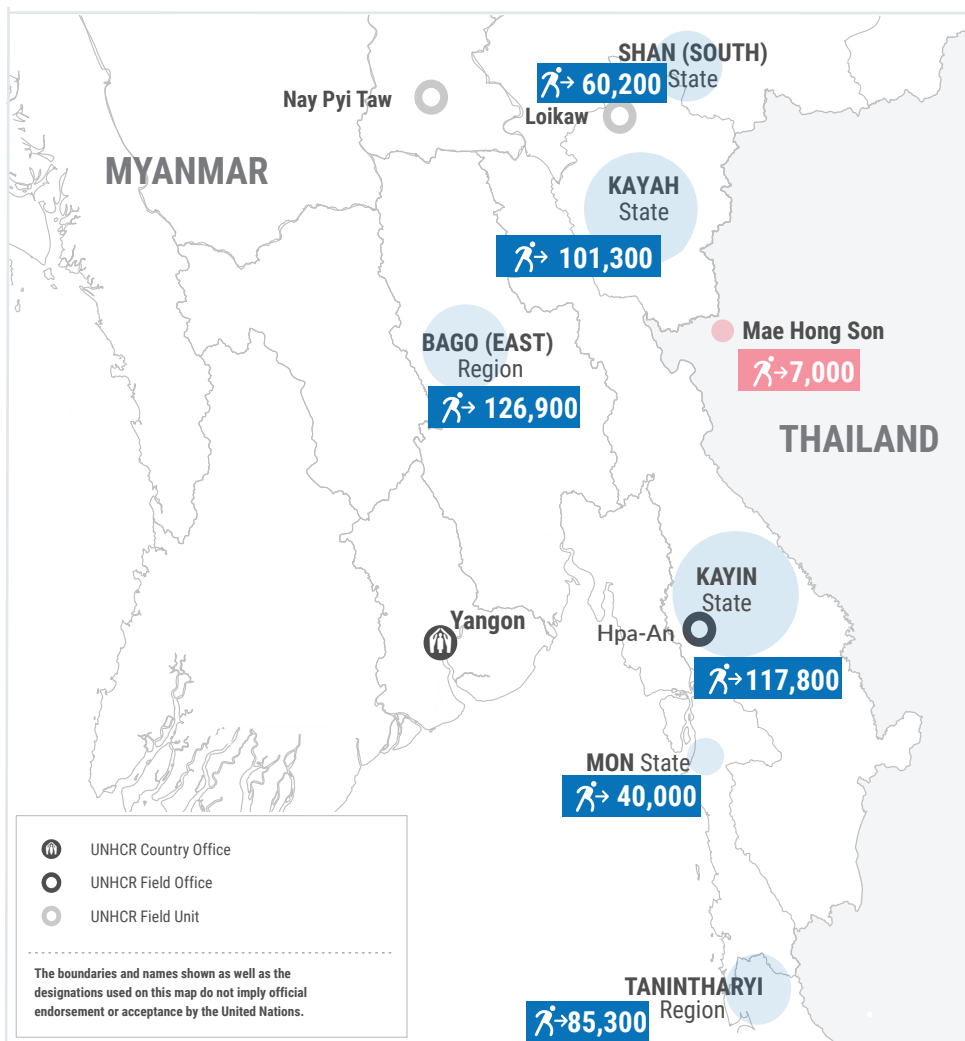
Across the border, some 7,000 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.

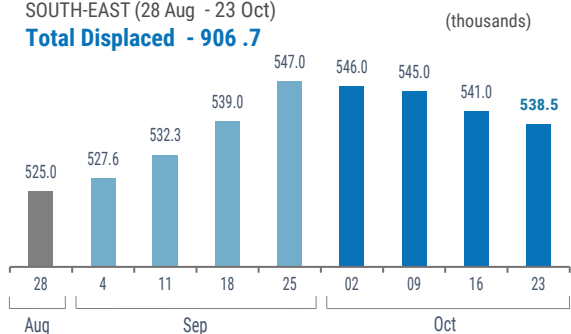
