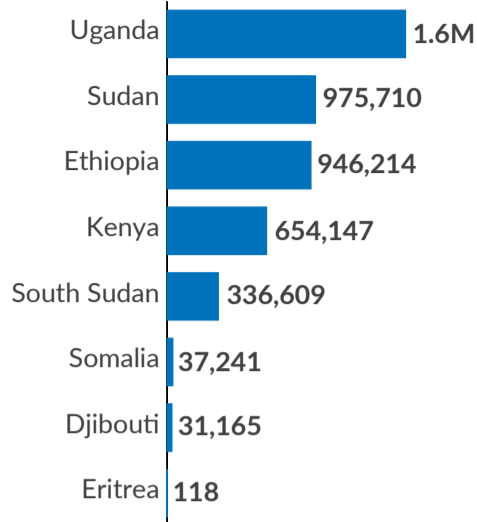

Returnees in 2023

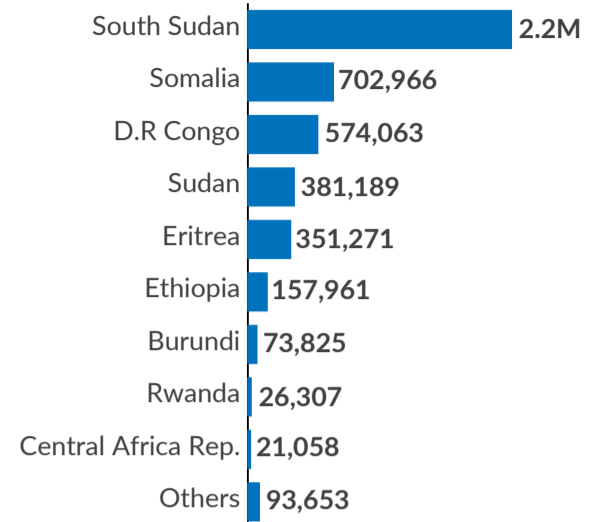
As of 30 September 2023, the IGAD region is host to 4.5 million refugees and asylum-seekers. The majority of refugees and asylum-seekers are from South Sudan, currently at 2.2 million. Some 14.5 million people are internally displaced in the region as a result of conflict and natural disasters. Over 350,000 refugees have returned to their countries of origin in 2023.

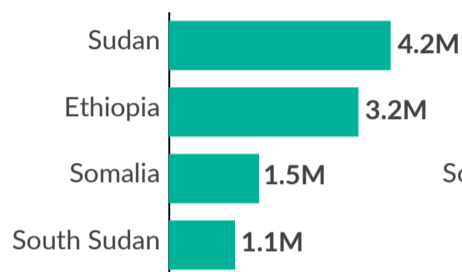
By Host countries



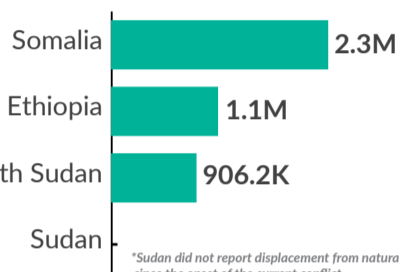
By Source countries



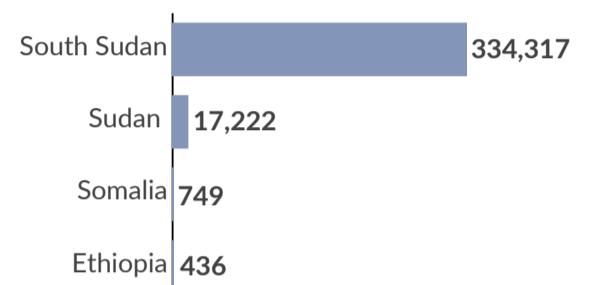
Conflict IDPs



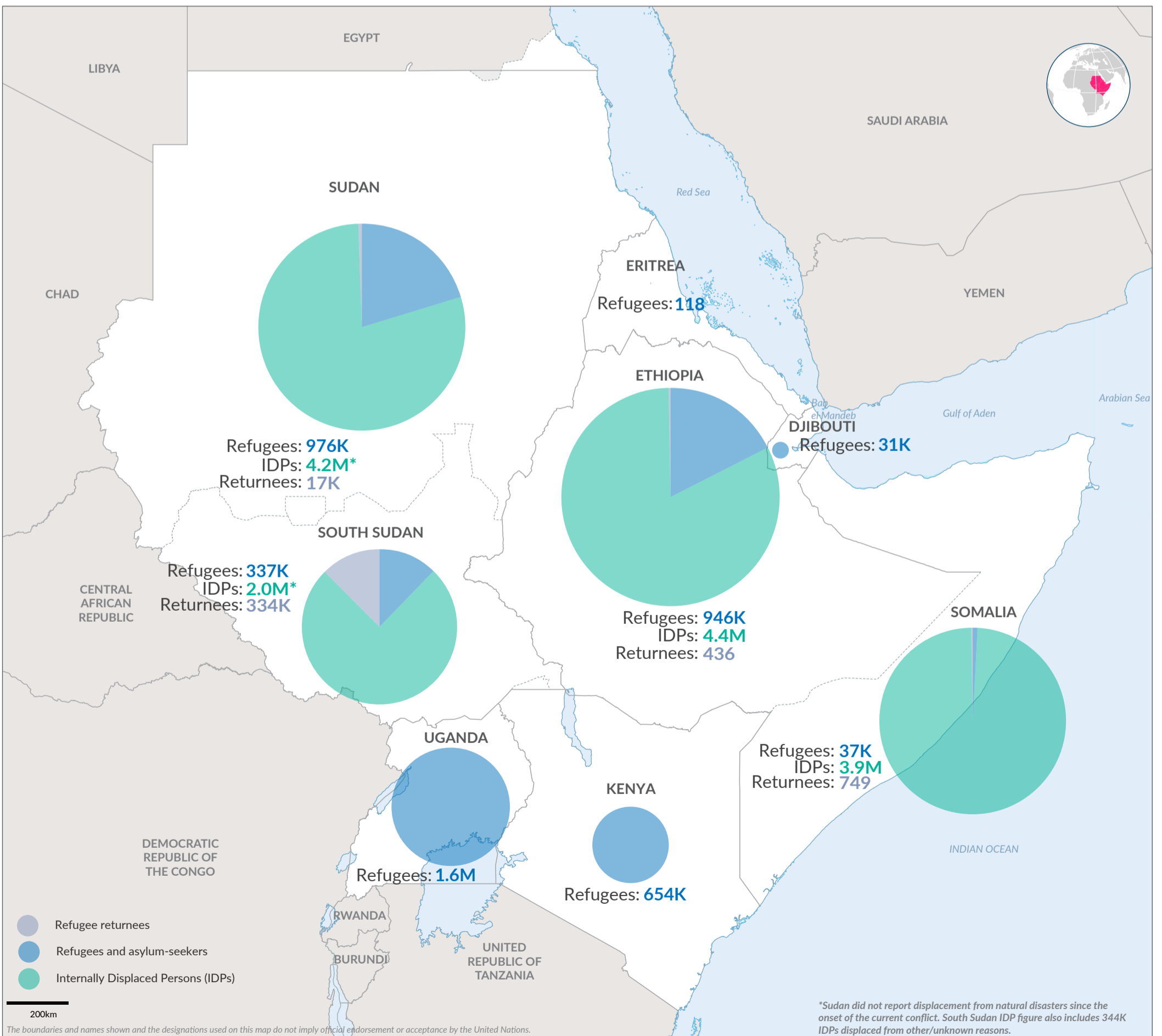
Natural disasters IDPs*
