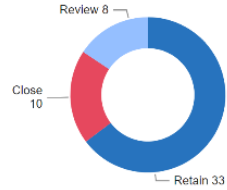

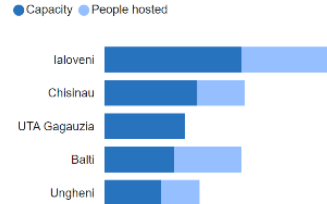

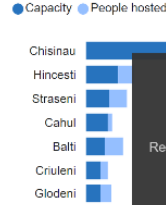

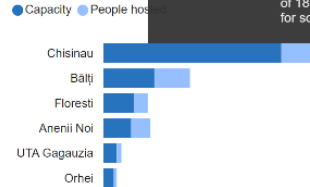

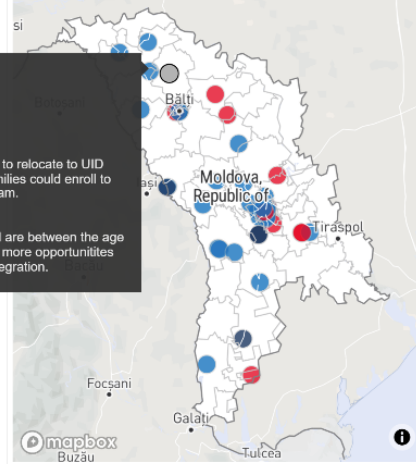
Recommendation: Retain

Comments: The most vulnerable group to relocate to UID 143 in Edinet, the other families could enroll to the rental assistance program.

Reasons for closure:

- Low occupancy
- Most of the people hosted are between the age of 18 to 64. This group has more opportunities for social and economic integration.

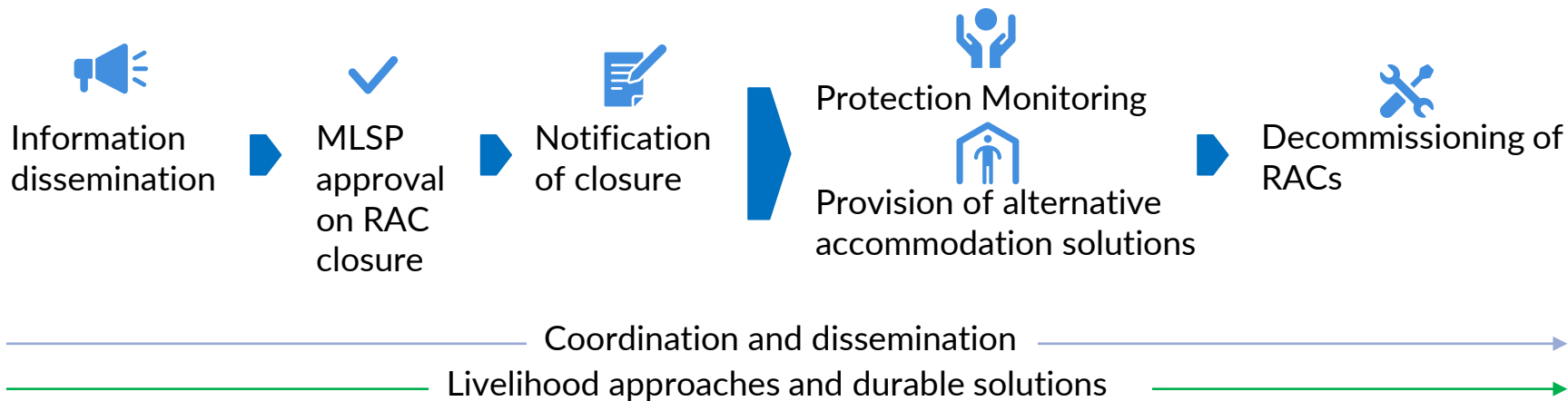

Initial Planning Assumptions:



Markets in Moldova are functional and accessible (UNHCR Cash PDM and Market Assessment)



Cash-based interventions should be prioritized and coordinated in line with existing cash transfer programmes and government winter assistance.

99% of HH surveyed during UNHCR Cash PDM (5th round) affirmed they were able to find items and/or services that they needed in markets and/or shops



Majority of refugees are staying in private accommodations, renting on their own or living with relatives/friends.



Importance of supporting community infrastructure also as a means of social cohesion.



NFIs should only be considered as a last resort measure.



Inclusion of refugees in Government Winterization Support Programmes.
