


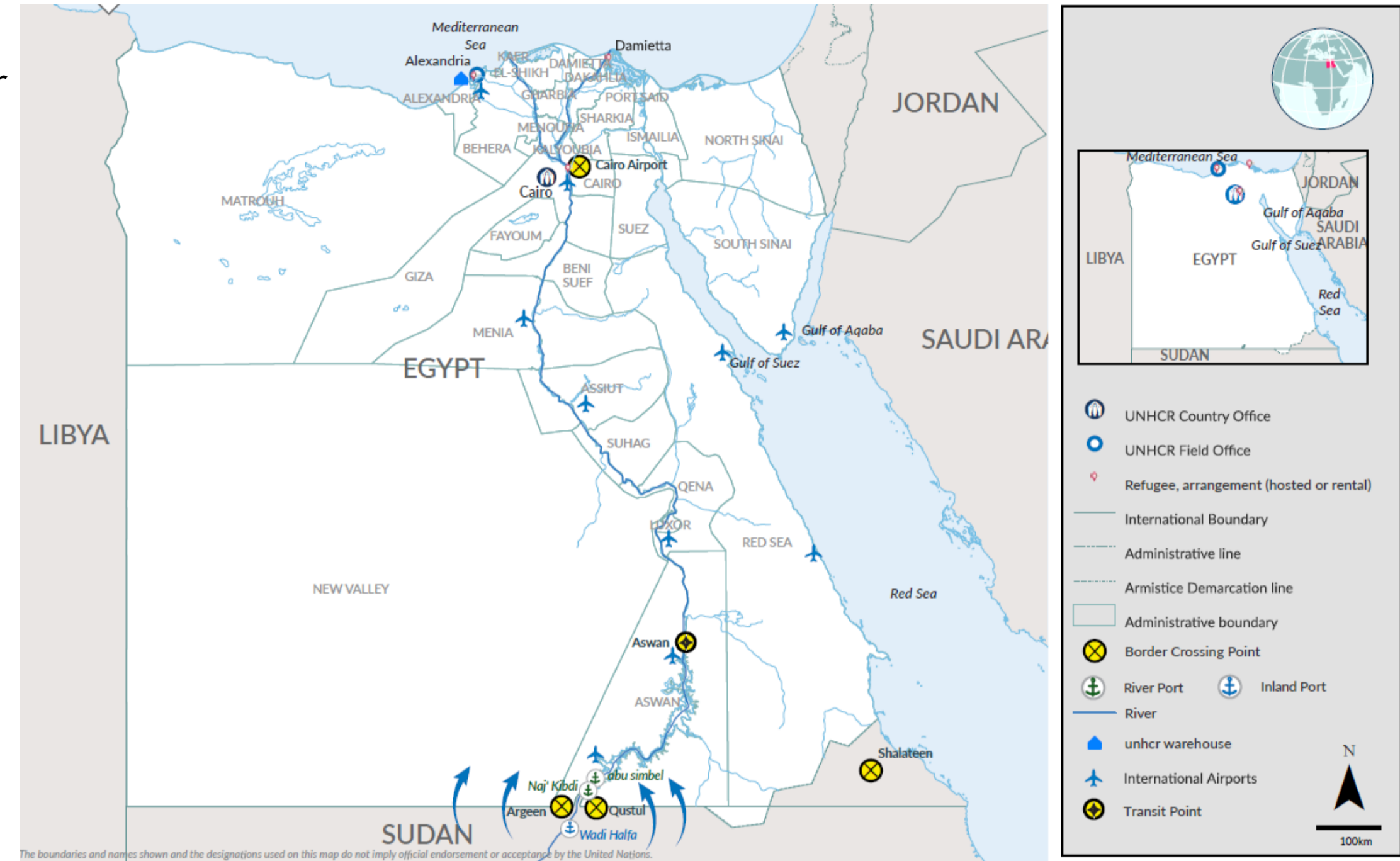


**Introduction**

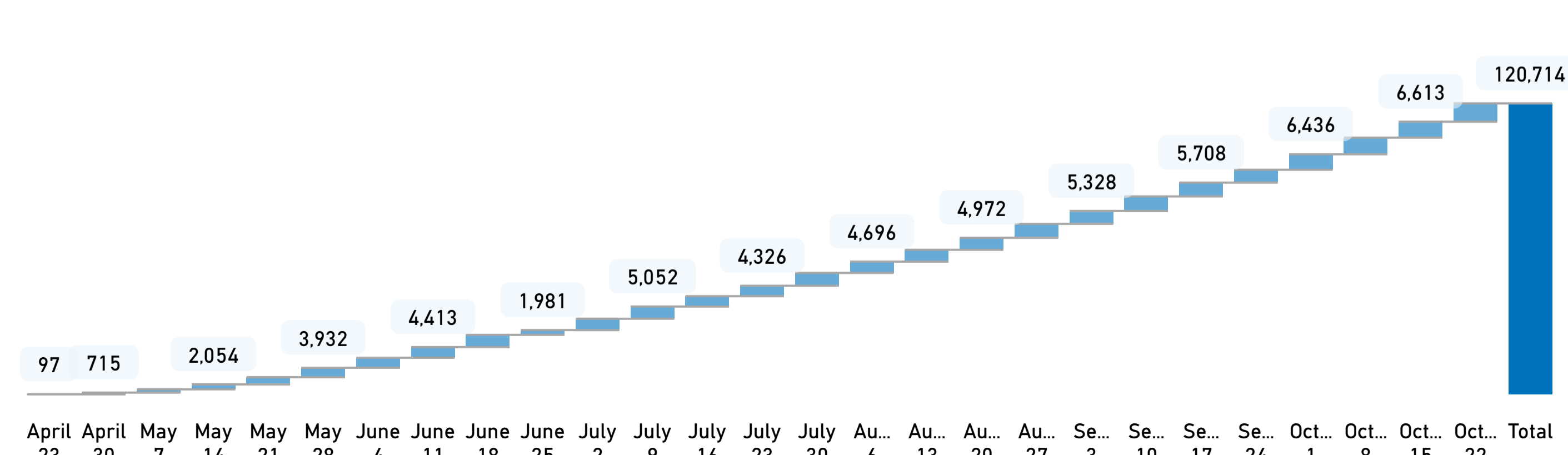
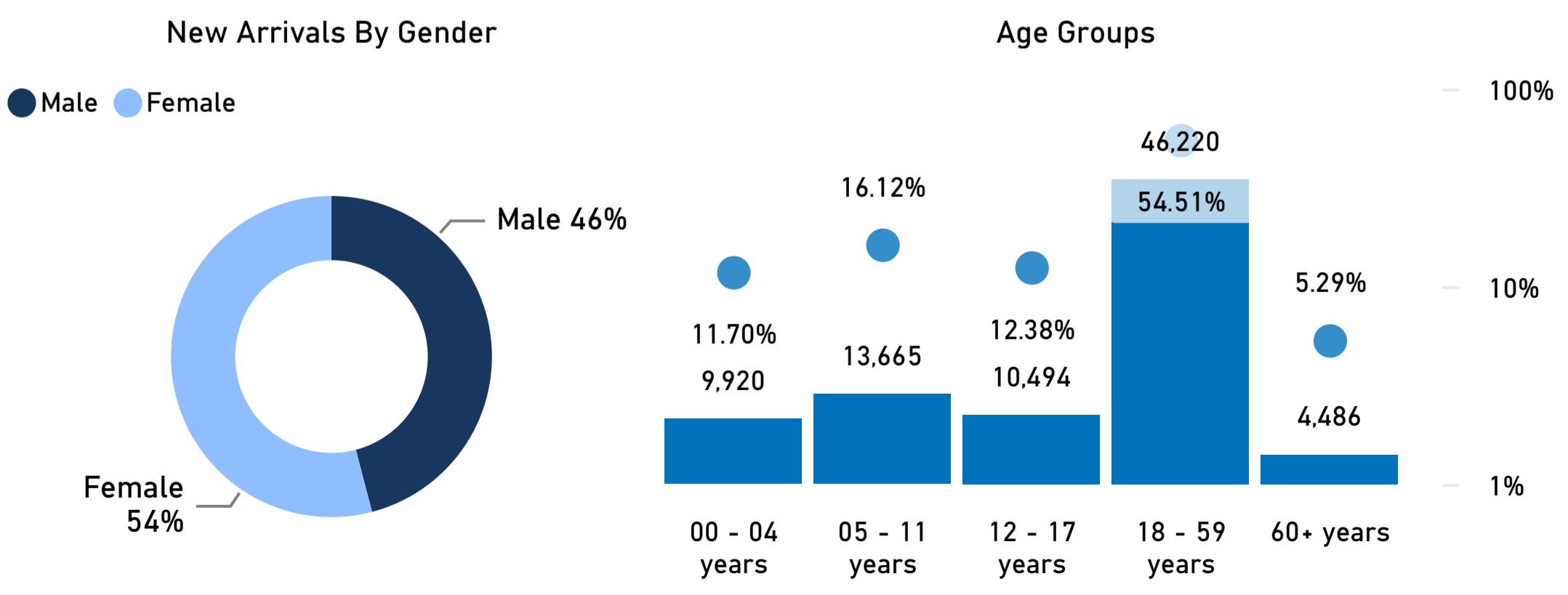
Due to the outbreak of conflict in Sudan between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and the Rapid Support Forces (RSF), over 337,230 (98% are Sudanese) have entered Egypt to flee the violence. This dashboard gives an overview of arrivals and registration trends.

-  **338,374** Individuals arrived (post conflict, since 15th April 2023) according to GOE
-  **120,714** Individuals who arrived from Sudan scheduled for registration (appointments)
-  **84,785** Newly registered individuals **70%** Registered, out of total individuals scheduled for registration



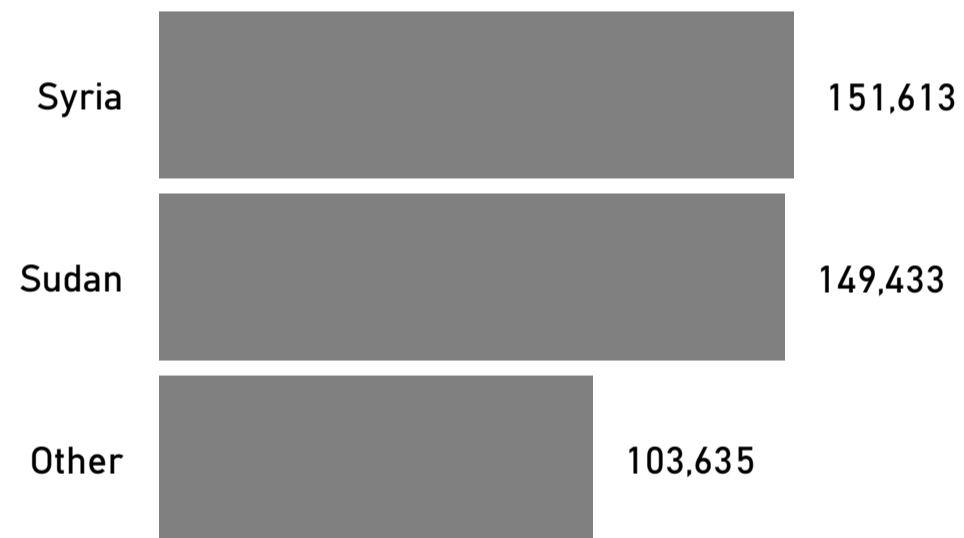

**Registration Appointment Trend**



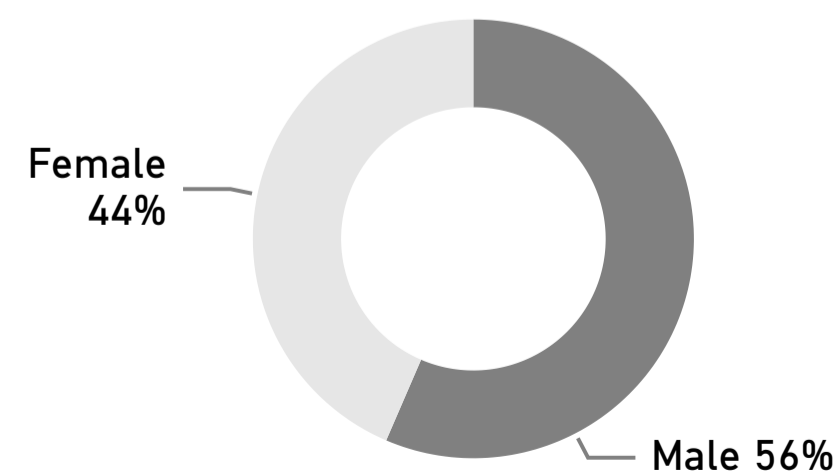

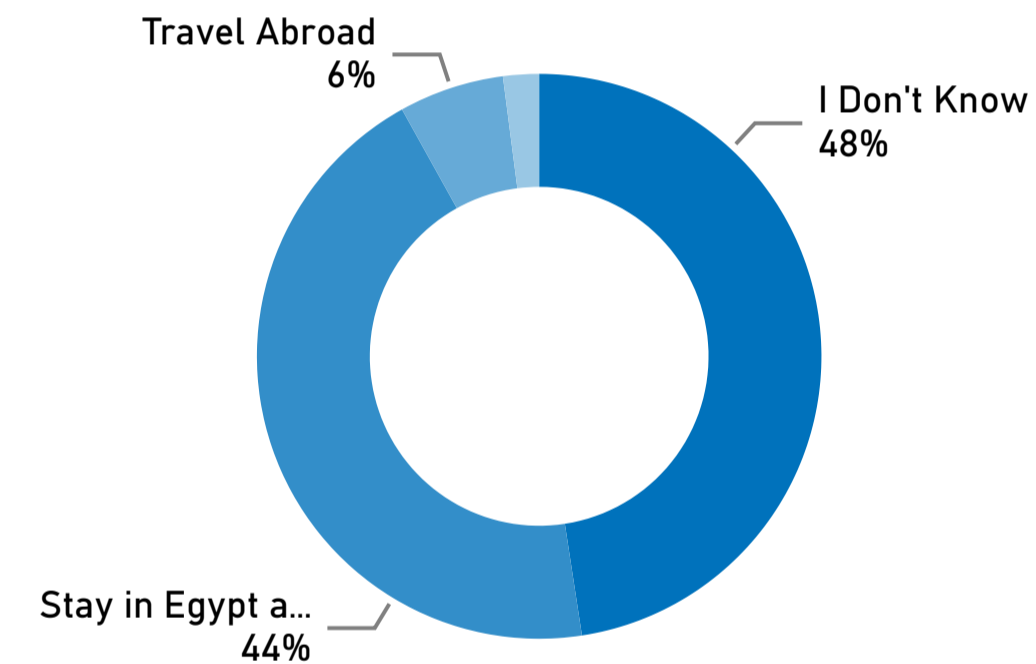


New arrivals from Sudan provided with appointments

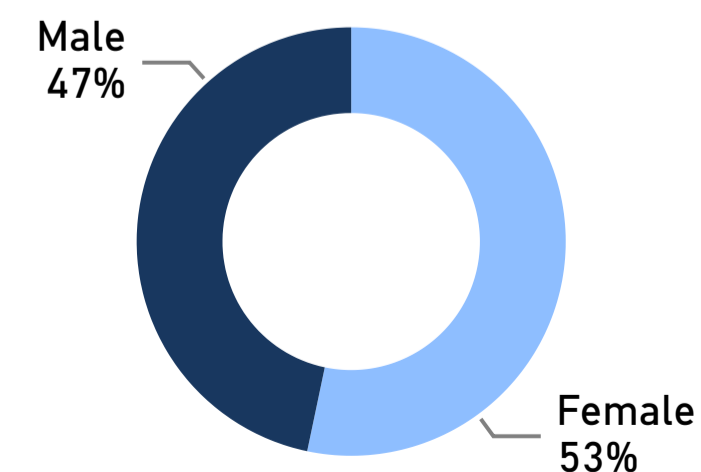

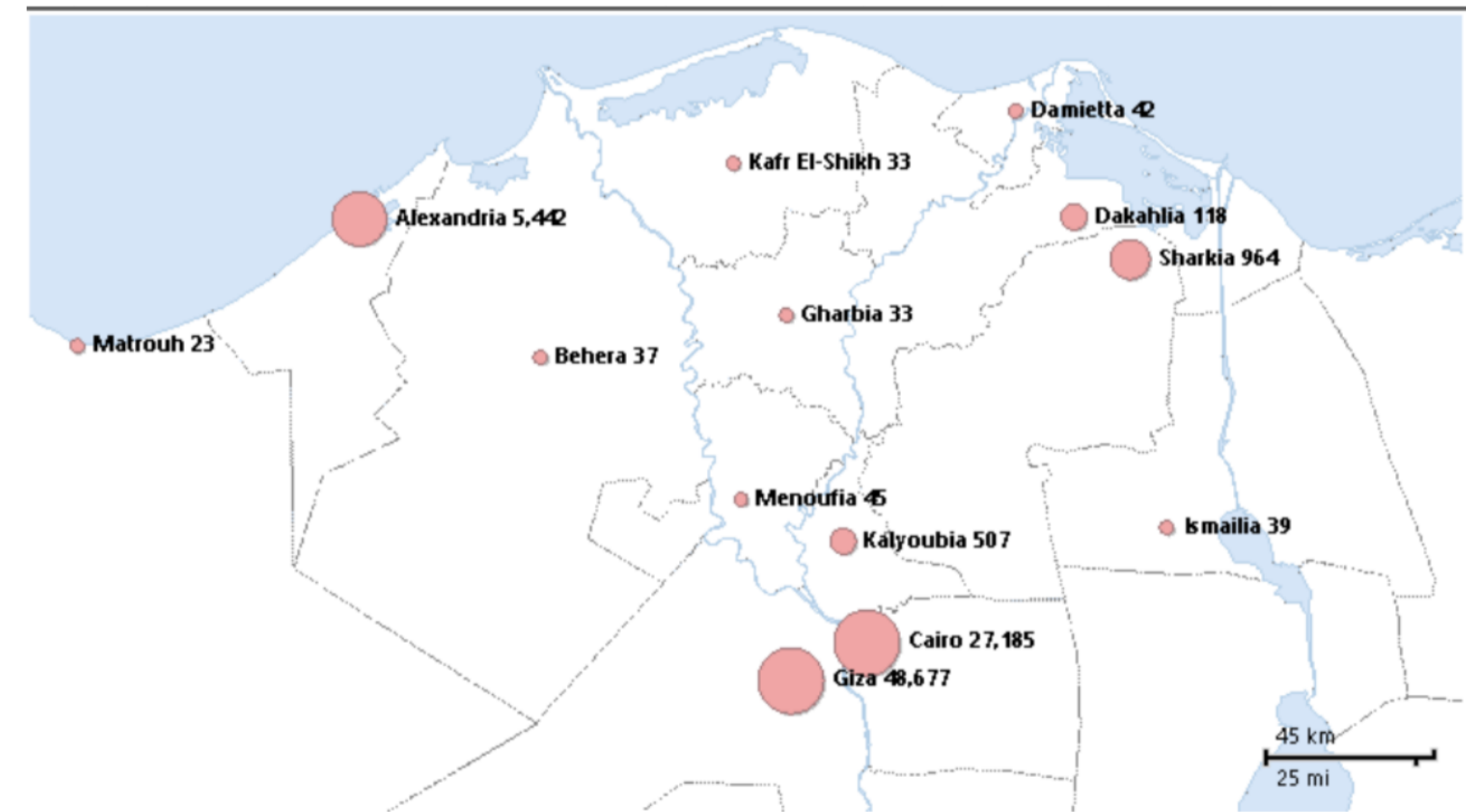
