WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of displaced people slightly increased from 531,500 last week to 532,200 this week.

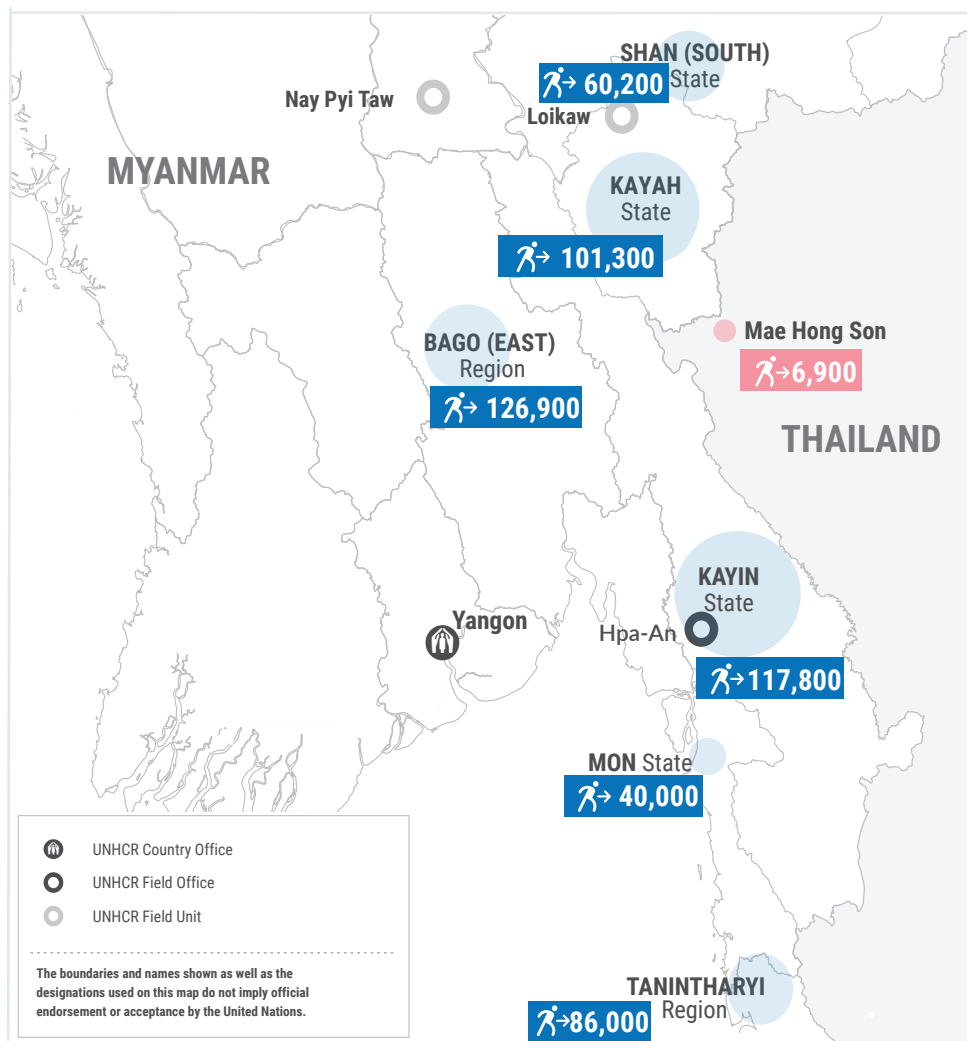
In Tanintharyi Region, due to intensified fighting, 1,204 IDPs were displaced in Myeik Township, among which 759 IDPs were displaced within Myeik Township and 445 IDPs were displaced from Tanintharyi Township as a secondary displacement.

Across the border, some 6,900 people from Myanmar remain displaced in Mae Hong Son Province, Thailand.

People who are estimated to be displaced by conflict in SE Myanmar (as of 30 Oct 2023).

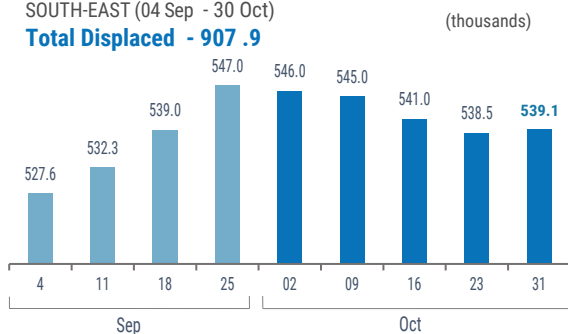

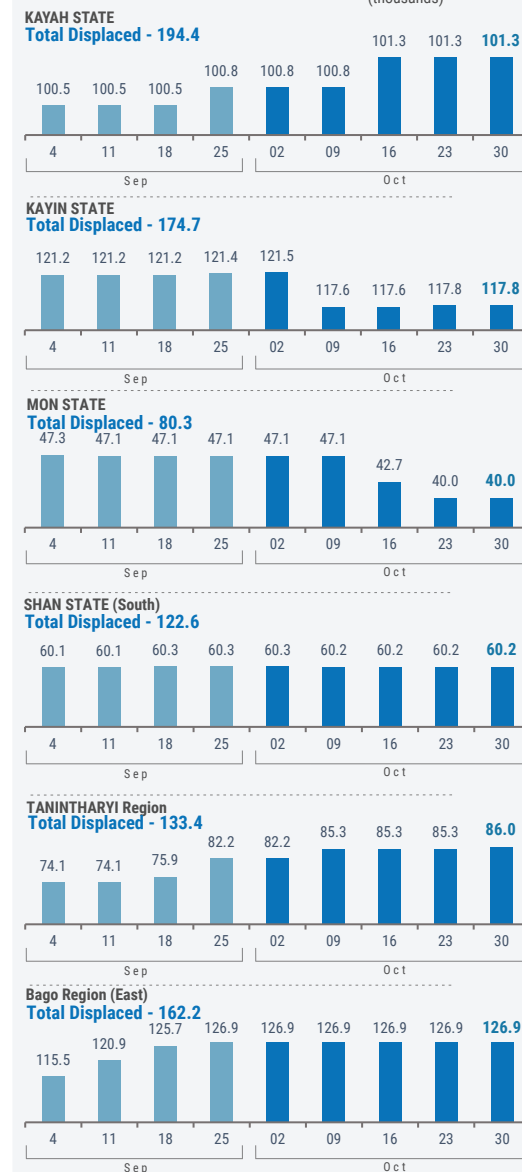
