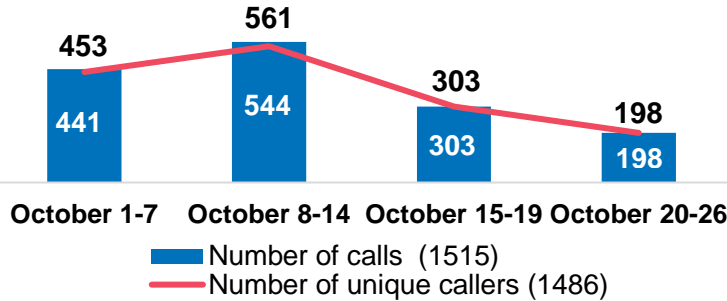

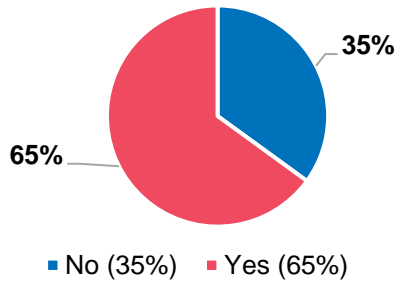


During October 20 to 26, UNHCR Armenia Hotline received 198 calls from 198 refugees from Nagorno Karabakh. 88% of the calls were received from refugees residing in Yerevan, Kotayk, Ararat and Armavir provinces. Except for two calls requesting information, all remaining calls were requesting for assistance. 84% of callers were female and 16% were men. 65% of callers reported having vulnerability in their household.

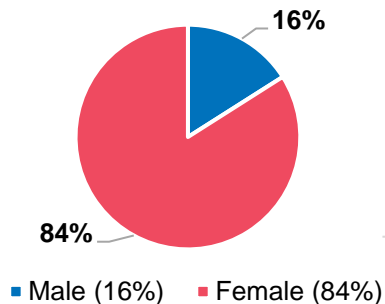
Among households who reported vulnerability, 46% reported having elderly at risk, 26% person with disability, 10% of households were multi-children households (with four or more children), 9% had a family member with serious medical condition, 8% were single-parent households with one or more children, and 1% had a pregnant or lactating women in the family.

Among most reported needs* (multiple-choice), accommodation was reported by 48%, bedding sets by 27%, food by 25%, household items by 18%, core relief items/hygiene kits by 10% and access to healthcare/medication by 8%.

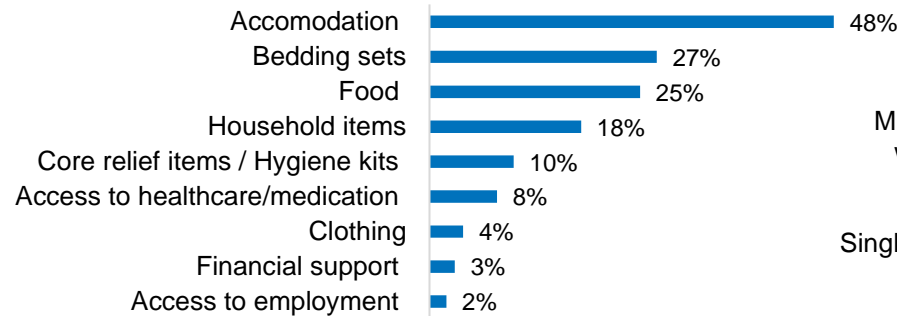
Vulnerability among callers



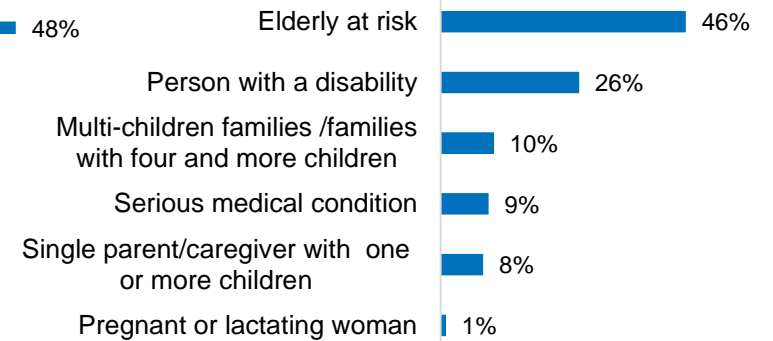
Gender of callers
