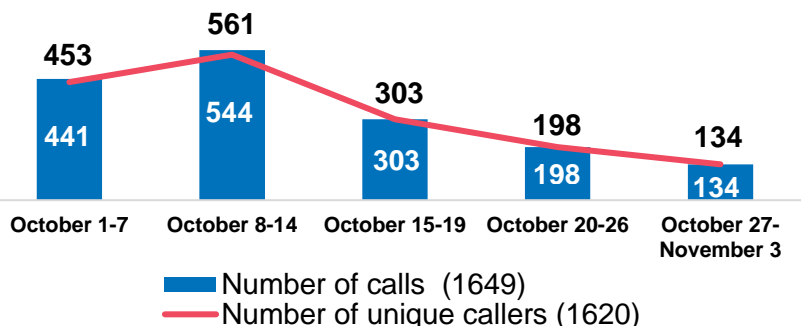


Weekly update (October 27-November 3, 2023)

Statistics

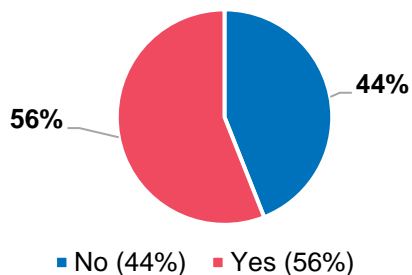


During October 27 to November 3, UNHCR Armenia Hotline received 134 calls from refugees from Karabakh. 81% of the calls were received from refugees residing in Yerevan, Kotayk, Ararat and Armavir provinces. Except for six calls requesting information, all remaining calls were requesting for assistance. 83% of callers were female and 17% were men. 56% of callers reported having vulnerability in their household.

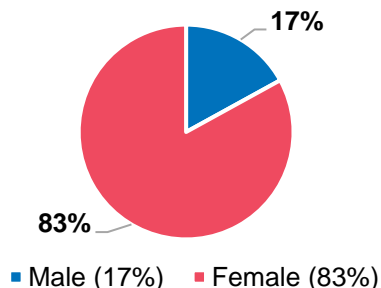
Among households who reported vulnerability, 44% reported having elderly at risk, 36% person with disability, 16% of households were multi-children households (with four or more children), 15% were single-parent households with one or more children and 14% had a family member with serious medical condition,

Among most reported needs* (multiple-choice), accommodation was reported by 37%, food by 24%, bedding sets by 15%, household items by 12%, core relief items/hygiene kits by 9% and access to healthcare/medication by 9%.

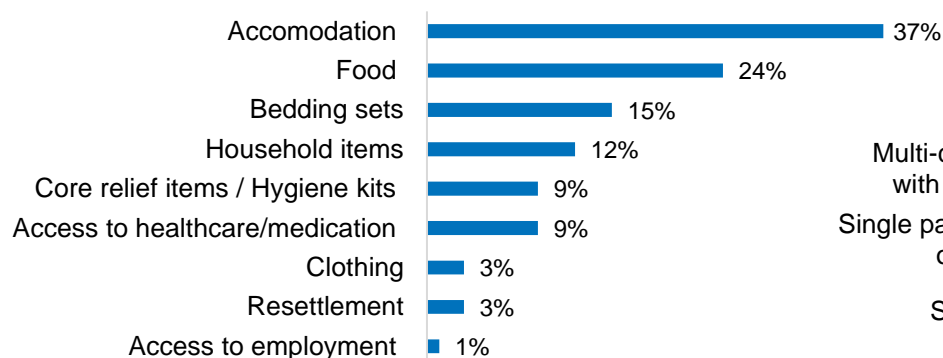
Vulnerability among callers



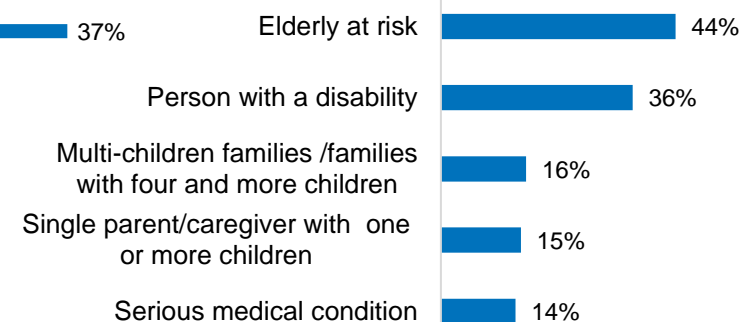
Gender of callers
