

## Context

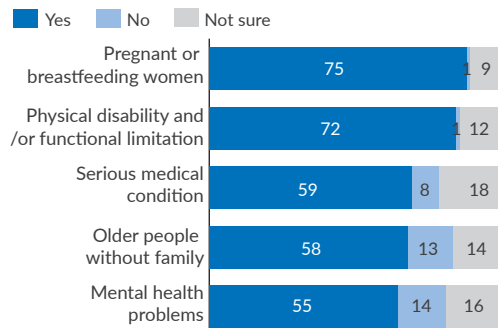
During the last week of September 2023, over 100,000 ethnic Armenians fled the Karabakh region and arrived in Armenia. The Rapid Needs Assessment was conducted by UN Inter-Sector Coordination Group Armenia in partnership with the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs (MLSA), and close collaboration with other Government Ministries, institutions, World Bank, and civil society organisation.



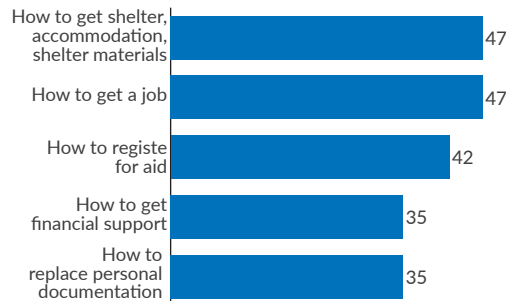

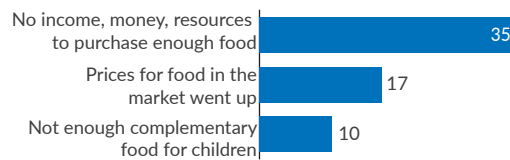
### Key Informants aware of any person with specific needs



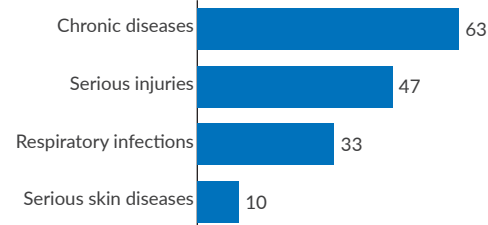
### Top 5 information needs requested by the community
