



Site Mapping and Monitoring (SMM) is a joint initiative of UNHCR and IOM which aims to ensure an adequate and timely understanding of the situation of the accommodation sites in Slovakia.

The results-oriented nature of SMM allows UNHCR and IOM, as well their partners, to better inform their response programmes and in particular by adapting prevention, advocacy, assistance and policy interventions tailored to the needs of accommodation sites hosting refugees.

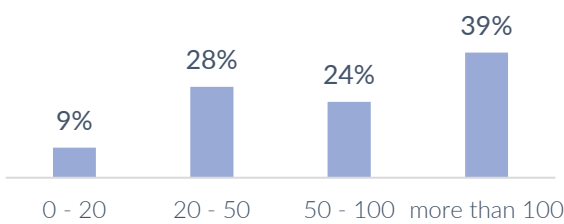

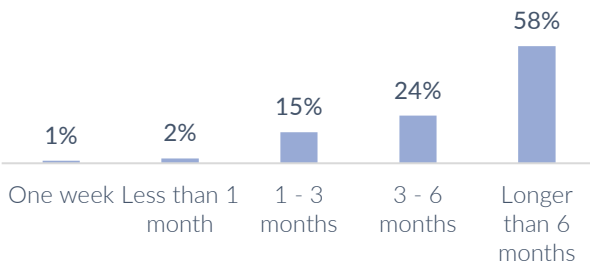
Accommodation sites mapped surveyed by region



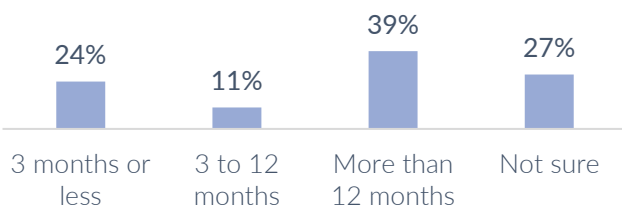
Sleeping capacity (individuals)



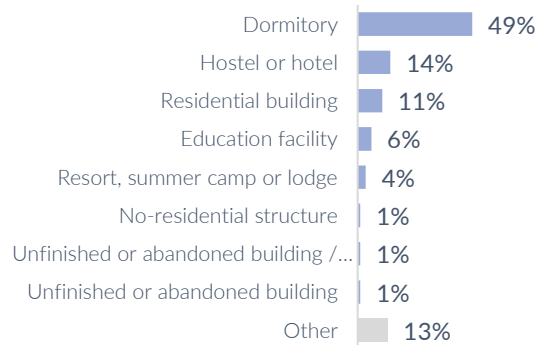
Average of stay

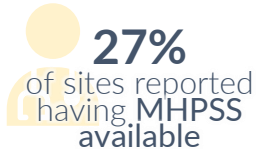
