2	<p>Partners updates:</p> <p>At the start of the updates discussion by partners, the CCCM SNCC introduced Deem Colleagues who will be covering CCCM in Qa'taba District, Al Dhale'e Governorate. Following that, the partners proceeded to explain the activities currently being implemented. The partners reported a severe shortage of food and water in the hosting sites for the displaced, despite ongoing advocacy efforts with service providers. Additionally, the partners presented the services that are still in urgent need of being covered by counterparts.</p>	<p>IOM provides updates on the new sites managed, and the ones they will hand over them.</p> <p>CCCM SNCC will hold a meeting with Deem next week on Sunday.</p>
3	<p>Site maintenance and community led projects.</p> <p>There are plans to carry out various activities at IDP sites to address the most critical gaps. Both TYF and Deem have confirmed that implementation will commence in early December, following the tender process and selection of contractors, while the International Organization for Migration has reported that gabion wall works have already commenced at Maslah Al Torkat site, with completion scheduled for December 5.</p>
