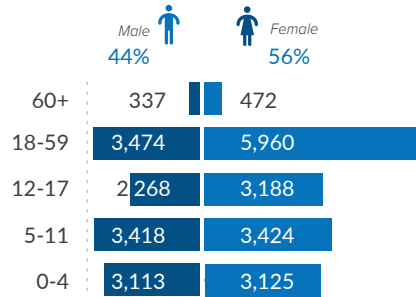

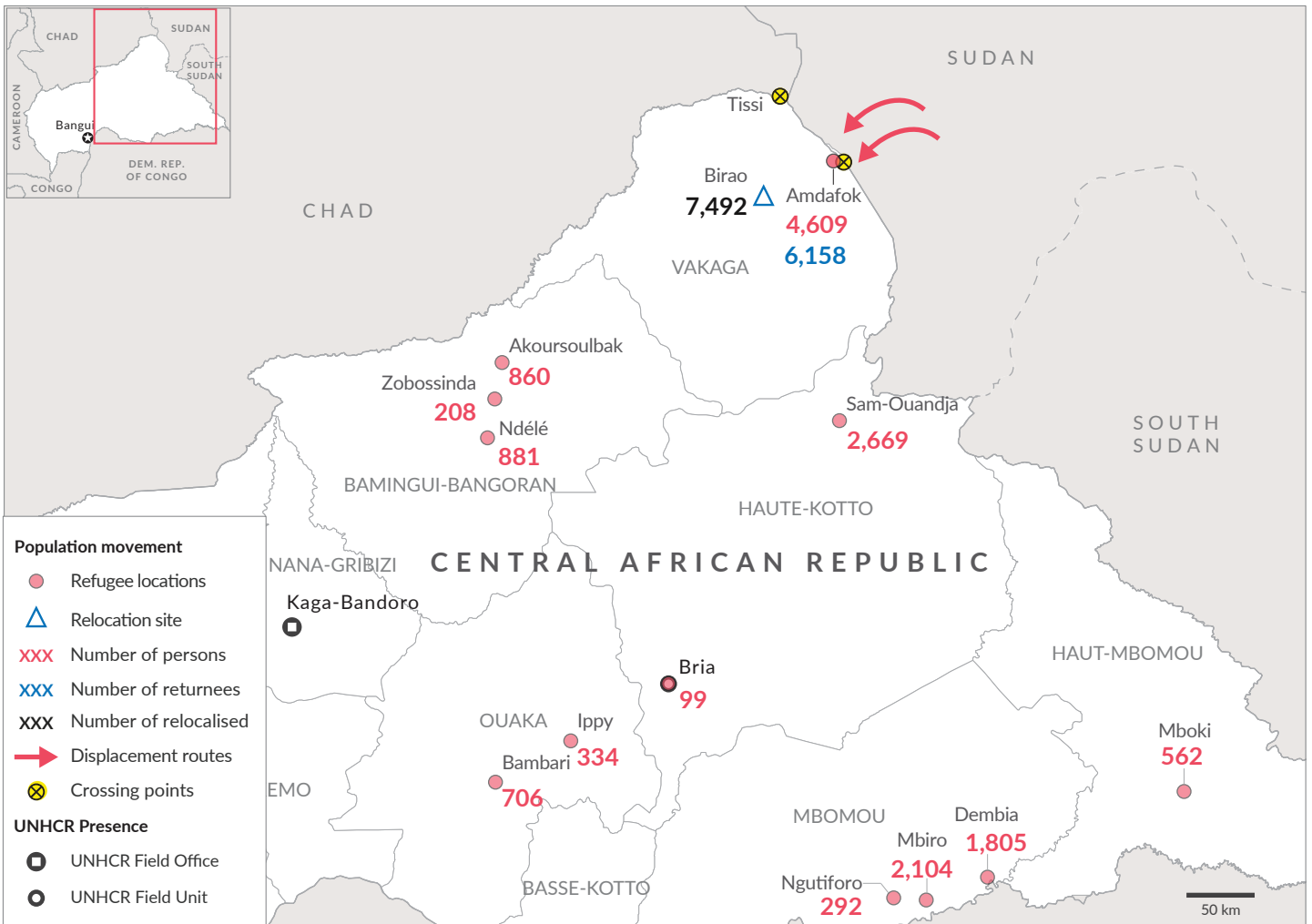
Breakdown of total number by age group and gender



Relocation of refugees to Birao

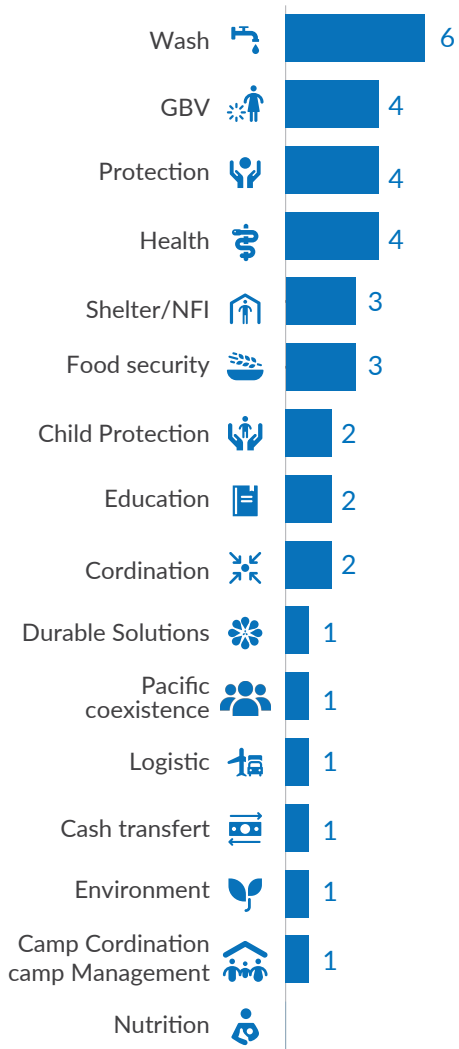
