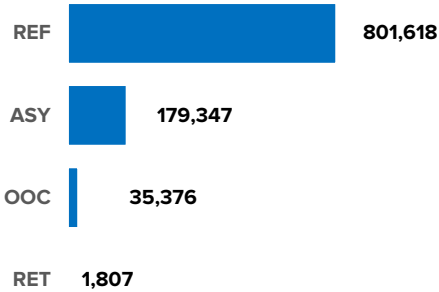
FORCIBLY DISPLACED PEOPLE & RETURNEES¹

As a result of persecution, conflict, violence, human rights violations, or events seriously disturbing public order.



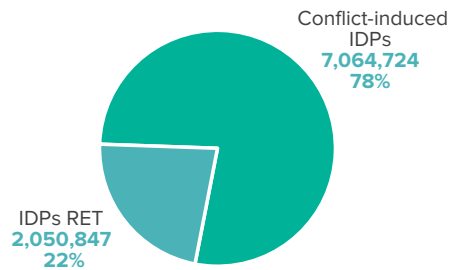

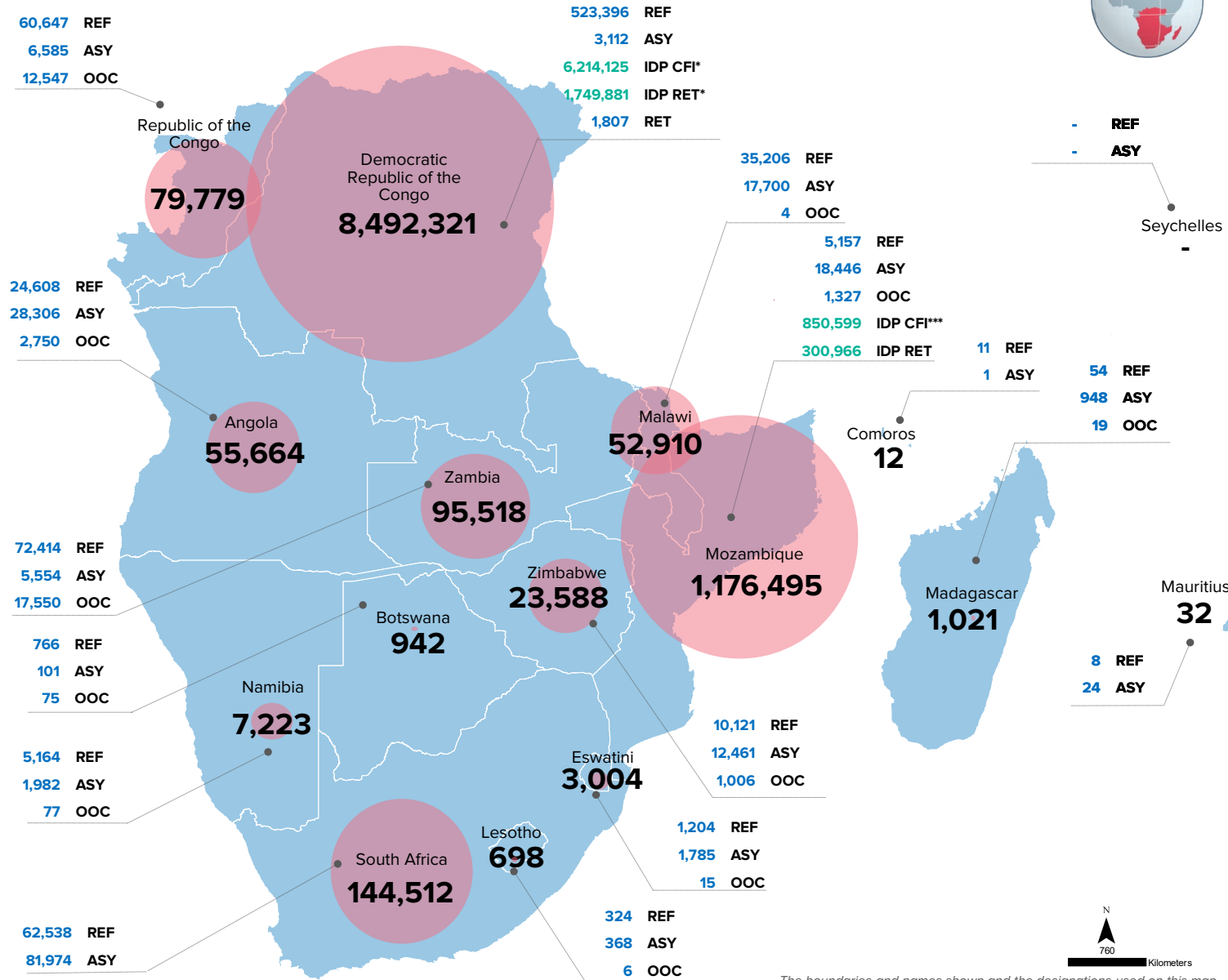

¹ In addition, there are 989,509 people displaced internally in the context of disasters and climate change. The displacement occurred in the following countries: Malawi (659,278), The Democratic Republic of the Congo (247,028), Mozambique (41,668) and Zimbabwe (41,535).
**As per Mozambique operation, the 850,599 IDPs conflict induced sourced from IDMC included 181,660 IDPs disaster induced (IOM/DTM Round 19). Therefore the total figure for IDPs disaster induced in Mozambique is 223,328 as of December 2023.
