1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The meeting began with a round of introductions, allowing attendees to introduce themselves and their respective organizations. 	
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Helpage has reported no significant changes in food assistance for refugees accommodated in 40 RACs, with 32 offering catering services and 8 conducting on-site cooking. Approximately 2600 beneficiaries are being served. • ACF (AAH) has been distributing snack kits at the Palanca and Otaci borders. From February 1st to February 27th, a total of 416 snacks were distributed at Otaci, including 209 meat snacks and 207 fish snacks. Additionally, 166 hot meals were provided at Otaci. At Palanca, 226 snacks were distributed, comprising 90 fish kits and 115 meat snacks, along with 188 hot meals. The number of snacks distributed in February increased compared to January due to the influx of refugees seeking temporary protection. • Hope 4 continues its monthly distribution of food boxes to refugees from their warehouse, starting from January. They are not visiting centers unless requested. On February 29th, 300 individuals will collect food boxes. They also distribute clothes and maintain their own registration system, dividing recipients by month. • Eco Razeni provides catering services to day centers, primarily in Chisinau and Durlesti, operating a total of 4 centers. They offer lunches from Monday to Friday and provide 25 food boxes (lunch and dinner) to two unaccredited RACs—benefiting 70 individuals. Their assistance will conclude by the end of March, and they are currently seeking another donor. 	WFP will facilitate the dissemination of information.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acted is engaged in monitoring RACs and is in the process of developing social canteen activities. They have not yet identified a donor but will share concrete details with members once available. • UNHCR has reported issues with packages smelling at Glodeni. WFP has requested the sharing of an official email for further correspondence.
