HIGHLIGHTS:

- 2024 ISCG meetings will be held on a bi-monthly basis under a hybrid modality. Next meeting tentatively 28 February, 2024:
 - Interagency Team will share calendar with tentative dates for 2024 bi-monthly meetings;
- 2024 RRP: Localization strategy resulted in a 60% increase in national partners, with 80 out of the total 103 partners being national NGOs. Partners encouraged to strengthen reporting.
- The 2024 RRP Regional Launch event is set to take place on the 15 January, 2024. RRP partners to share with Interagency Team suggestions of RLO to participate at regional side event Deadline: 15 December - Contact: busconir@unhcr.org or linkewit@unhcr.org
 - Poland Chapter 2024 RRP launch event possibly mid-February can be an opportunity to build relations with new Government counterparts,
- Funding opportunities for local NGOs/RLOs: POP-Fund, from a total of 135 submission, between 20-30 organizations are going through a final evaluation, with results expected by 19/20 December. Interagency Team will support in analyzing alignment of submissions with 2024 RRP.

Updates from Sectors/ Working groups:

- **PROTECTION:** The Sector shared the summary findings and recommendations of the Joint Protection Analysis, English version available at <https://data.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/104584> , Polish version at <https://data.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/105155> and Ukrainian version at <https://data.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/105150>
Sector will continue its efforts to strengthen the **Protection Monitoring and Analysis Taskforce** to support an interagency evidence-based protection response.
- **GBV Safe Audit:** presentation of the GBV Safety Audit highlighted intersectional GBV risks factors relevant for all sectors. GBV Sub-Sector willing to facilitate and support the safety audit/assessments within other sectors;
- **SHELTER, HOUSING AND ACCOMMODATIONS:** The Sector Relocations met with Ministry of Interior, Anna Karpińska on 23rd October to discuss strategy towards CCs, highlighting the need to count on updated information from Government on CCs. Mol representatives informed that a detailed report for 2023 will be shared in February. The Sector will launch new quarterly factsheets with strategic updates, to be used as a tool for advocacy with donors/authorities, fundraising.
- **AAP:** The APP Network shared their current process of identifying a local organization as co-chair for next year. Contact: kampire@unhcr.org
- **PSEA:** The Network agreed to present main PSEA challenges way forward on the next ISCG meeting, focusing on issue of PSEA Mainstreaming across sectors and possible gaps in Interagency referrals.
